To avoid confusion, it is best to avoid using the term “margin of error” or “margin of sampling error” in conjunction with non-probability samples.</p>	<p><b>The overall sample consisted of Hispanic citizens in Colorado, n=783, with a Credibility Interval (CI), similar to a poll's margin of error (MOE) of +/- 3.4 percentage points.</b></p> <p><b>The registered voter sample consisted of registered voters in Colorado, n=473, with a Credibility Interval (CI) similar to a poll's margin of error (MOE) of +/- 4.5 percentage points.</b></p> <p><b>The non-registered citizen sample consisted of non-registered citizens in Colorado, n=310, +/- 5.5 percentage points.</b></p>

A description of how the weights were calculated, including the variables used and the sources of weighting parameters, if weighted estimates are reported.</p>	<p><b>The data sets were weighted by gender, age, education, party registration, and region. It is important to remember that subsets based on gender, age, party breakdown, ethnicity, and region carry with them higher margins of error, as the sample size is reduced.</b></p>
