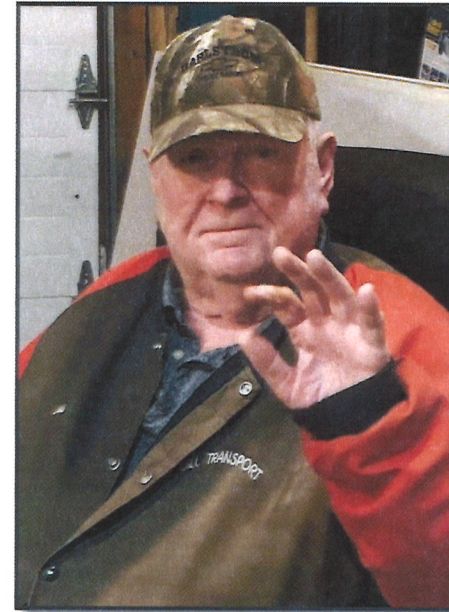




### *Prayer For My Dad*
