Dear Ramanda,

The DMTCB is pleased to notify you that you have met the requirements for the BC-DMT.

Registration entitles you to be a Board Certified-Dance/Movement Therapist and to place the initials "BC-DMT" after your name when used on official or professional papers and documents. The BC-DMT level represents the advanced level of professional skill and signifies that you can provide DMT training and supervision and engage in private practice.

Your certificate of registration on which your name will appear as **Ramanda Brockett** is sent under separate cover. Your permanent BC-DMT number is **BC-DMT-1538**. Please make a note of this for your records. This number will be kept on file at the National Office.

Board Certified-Dance/Movement Therapists are permitted to do the following:

- List the initials BC-DMT after your name
- Train/educate, advise, and supervise R-DMT students
- Advertise as a BC-DMT when you offer training/workshops, this includes advertising through the ADTA Newsletter
- Write letters of recommendation for R-DMT applicants
- Serve as a member of the ADTA, DMTCB or committees that require BC-DMT certification.

IMPORTANT NOTE:

To maintain your registry status and to professionally use the title Board Certified-Dance/Movement Therapist or the initials BC-DMT, you must:

- (1) pay the annual registry maintenance fee, complete 100 hours of Continuing Education every five years to maintain registry (unless you are registered at the Reduced Practice status) and comply with the audit requirement if you are randomly selected.
- (2) support and abide by the ADTA Code of Ethical Standards of Practice (if you do not maintain your credential and continue to identify yourself as a BC-DMT, you are in violation of the ADTA Code of Ethics)

We encourage you to continue developing your skills and maintain your level of expertise through continued professional education.

Congratulations and we wish you every satisfaction in your profession. (Your name will also be listed in the ADTA newsletter as a new BC-DMT certificant. Please let us know if you would like it to be omitted.)
