The Home & School team is looking for a couple people to help out at Fall Fest for an hour time slot serving pizza and drinks in the kitchen. This is a fun way to fulfill your volunteer hours for the month! You can also fulfill your volunteer hours by helping after the event doing the following: bathrooms will need to be checked for cleanliness, hallway rugs and stage will need to be vacuumed, putting away tables and chairs, sweeping and mopping gym floor, clean kitchen and check entrance ways for dirty glass. At the end of November, charges will be applied to statements for families who have not fulfilled their volunteer duties. We'd much prefer to have your help.

### After-School Extracurricular Opportunities

Beginning in November we are excited to offer some new after school activities for students. If your child doesn't typically stay for after-school care, we still want to invite

them to participate in any of these activities they choose. On Mondays and Wednesdays **Emmanuel LiFranc**, who teaches French in the public schools, is offering to teach **French** to children and adults who want to learn the language. These classes will be held from 3:30-4:30. On Thursdays, **Ms. Diane LaFlair** will be starting a **baton twirling club** if enough students are interested. The cost for any of these activities will be \$3 per day. If students are already in after-care there is no extra charge, except for approximately \$20 for a baton. **Parents must ensure that students have transportation home. If they are not picked up by 4:30, parents will be charged for after-school care at the standard rates.** Please contact Mrs. King in the office to let her know if you intend for your young person to participate in any of these activities so leaders know how many to plan for.
