RAS Early Registration for 19-20 Open now!

Both new and current students are eligible to pay enrollment fees for the 19-20 school year.

Early: \$175 (March 1-31)
Regular: \$225 (April 1-June 9)
Summer: \$250 (June 10 and after)

Current students are guaranteed a seat in classrooms until March 31. Starting April 1, open seats are available to new students. If you haven't registered by the end of March, your child may not have a space in the classroom. Both 5/6 and 7/8 classrooms look to be totally full next year. We want all our current students back so make sure you get this taken care of in March!

Classroom Placement, 19-20

For those who are registering for the 19-20 school year and wish to put in a request for a specific friend or classroom, the classroom placement request form is available when you complete registration.

When assigning classrooms over the summer, we look carefully at classroom balance (even number of boys and girls, even number per grade, etc.) and the teachers give their input on social dynamics and learning styles of the different students. We do, however, also consider parent request. Filling out a classroom placement request does not guarantee that your child will be placed in the classroom that you name, but we are always happy for your feedback and ideas. 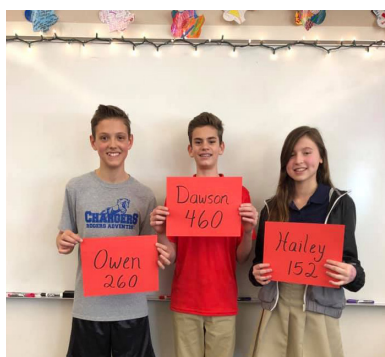
K-1 Circus, April 7 from 3-4:30

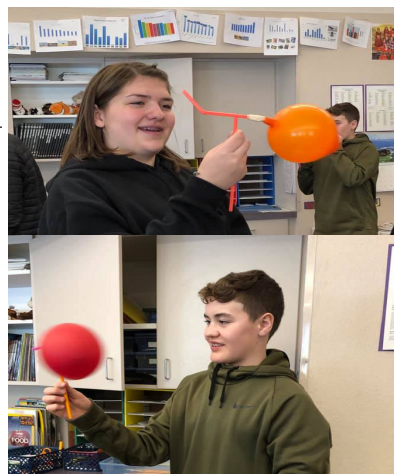
