I have 39 years' experience as a Structural / Civil Engineer and Project Manager with major building projects in United Kingdom, Middle East and Australia. I have been a company director in Australia since 1989. In 2007 he founded MAJCON, providing corporate and government NSW with three technical areas of expertise:

- **Structural / Civil Engineering**, Design Documentation and site certification of construction to building projects to a value of \$50M
- **Building Repairs** as Project Manager comprising diagnostic reports, repair Tender Documents and Project Management of the repairs to a value of \$5M.
- **Condition / Dilapidation Survey** leads a team of structural engineers, in the pre and post dilapidation survey of 1000's of adjoining properties, roads and Council assets to major developments and road infrastructure throughout Sydney CBD and Metropolitan area.

I have been a Director of The Association of Consulting Structural Engineers, NSW since 2007. As President in 2012 I led the reform of the Articles of Association, oversaw its autonomy and self-governance away from Consult Australia which has resulted in substantial membership growth and new-found high-profile corporate sponsorship. I master-planned the Association's Mission Statement and 5-year Strategic Plan in 2012 and currently I am leader the governance, corporate sponsorship and membership committees. I have also been responsible for events which has seen the development of the iconic ACSE Golf Day at Avondale golf and partnered with various small and local charities.

I have played squash for 44 years and have held numerous senior club administration roles. Between 2011-2016 I was Chairman of Briars@Thornleigh Squash Club and was the leader in the amalgamation of the two squash clubs. Since then Briars squash have won the NSW Premier League, 2015 and was voted Best Club at Squash Australia's Annual Awards 2016.

In 2015 I was elected to the Board of Directors of Briars Sports with over 1500 sporting members participating in six different sports. As chairman of the Building Committee I have responsible for planning the strategic future wellbeing of the club with alterations and additions to the club premises to a value of \$1.5M.

- 2. Existing Centres** Created best practice guidelines for the successful operation of a squash centre with separate ideas for Individually owned centres.
- 3. Centremark** is to be developed to create better links between squash facilities and SA through a new centre benefits portal/programme.

I am dedicated to leading a pathway for increasing participation in squash through new facilities and world class events from grass roots to the elite level. In order to achieve these goals, I need the support from the Squash Australia members and continuity of my current tenure as Director of Squash Australia.
