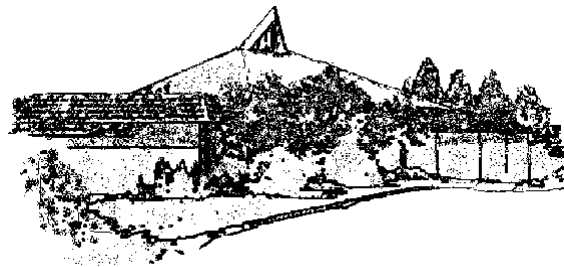
Church Needs
