

### Notes on the Mission Prayer on 7<sup>th</sup> August 2002

At the Mission Prayer Meeting on Sunday 7<sup>th</sup> August we were privileged to have an excellent presentation from R and S and to pray for their time in UK; for the challenges of working in that country; and for their further work on return. Please remember the family while they are here with us, and when they plan to return on 1<sup>st</sup> October.

This event did not allow time for prayer for our other mission partners, but we received the following requests which we all can include in our prayers during the coming month:

R and J are helping to develop an online teaching programme for those who have suffered trauma in their target country. They ask for prayer for the post production work and efforts to film some example stories for the series. J is also creating a new website for the Bible courses and needs block time, wisdom and inspiration for this. Their son Ethan does not have student accommodation needed in a month's time. Please pray.

Holly (who spoke recently at DBC). She sends a good report of settling in her new country and making friends. However, she does ask for prayer that the good plans for her accommodation will finally materialise (not always honoured in that country). Do also pray that the design projects in their early stages will develop soon and that she will be able to use her professional skills before too long.

Julia seems very happy at present, but please pray that she will know when best to return to the UK, after over ten years of service in South Africa. Her work with the children needs a permanent building and we pray for better involvement by Cheshire Homes (South Africa) in planning for that.
