OBITUARY

Robert Louis Simms, Sr., a beloved husband, father, grandfather, and great-grandfather passed away peacefully on September 1, 2023. Robert was born in Cedar Creek, Texas on September 4, 1939, to the late Earline and Lula Bell Simms.

Robert attended Emile High School and received his GED. In school Robert participated in basketball, football, and track. While participating in track, he received the nickname of "Slow."

Robert accepted Christ as his Lord and Savior at an early age and was baptized at Lone Star Missionary Baptist Church under the leadership of the late Reverend J. H. Penn. He later joined Pleasant Bethany Baptist Church under the leadership of the late Reverend J. E. James. He was ordained as a Deacon on December 31, 1965. On June 8, 1963, Robert married Ruby J. Meeks, to this union two children were born. Robert and Ruby were blessed with an extended family of five children.

Robert was employed at Elgin Butler Brick during his earlier years. For forty-five years he worked in the retail industry from which he retired. During the course of his employment, the store had a few name changes: Handy Andy, Foodland, Market Basket, and finally City Market.

Besides church, Robert enjoyed dominoes, watching the Dallas Cowboys, Walker Texas Ranger, and Gunsmoke. His most joy was playing with his great-granddaughter, Cecelia Rose (CeCe) Gibson who was his partner in crime.

Robert was preceded in death by two children, Robert Louis, Jr., and Yolanda Gibson; his parents, Earline and Lula Bell Simms; and sister, Helen Short.


