From Pastor's Desk

The scripture for today **Judges 21:25**

“In those days there was no king in Israel: every man did that which was right in his own eyes.”

This phrase is the prevailing theme of the book of Judges. In addition to our scripture for today, it can be found in chapters 17:6, 18:1 and 19:1. God was their King, but the people did not recognize His Lordship and authority. Consequently, every person decided for themselves what was right. From time to time during this period the people would repent and God would raise up judges to deliver them, but this temporary respite lasted only as long as the judge lived. The people soon went back to their lawless ways. The sanctuary that God had directed Moses to build was in the land and the Law of God was residing among them, but they chose the idols of the heathens rather than the will of God.

This sad condition resembles in many ways the condition of the Laodicean church today. The things of the world are elevated to undeserved levels of importance and those things are given the time and attention that should be given to God. We then try to sanctify our selfishness with vain rationalizations and prayers polluted with self-will. May God bring His church to the place of complete surrender to His will and a willingness to come to the cross of Christ and die to self. Then, and only then, will the world see the light of the kingdom of God in His church and the manifestation of His glory among His people.
