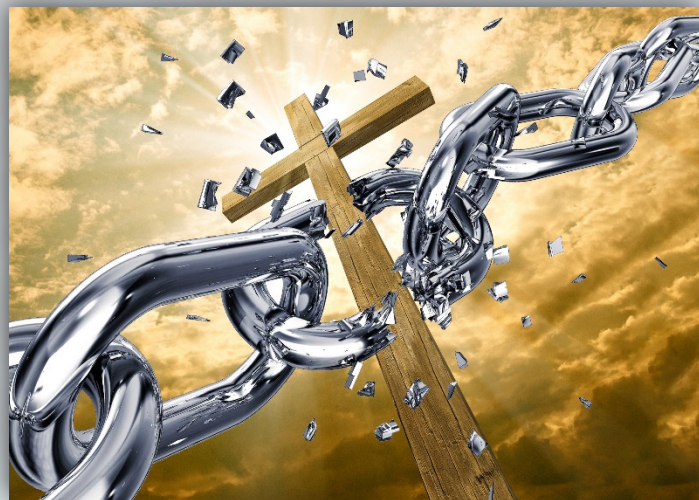


# The Broken Chain
