

Hermina (Zomer) Rozeboom, daughter of Herman and Helena (Spaans) Zomer Sr., was born April 25, 1926, at Armour, South Dakota. She grew up in the Corsica, South Dakota area and attended school through the 8th grade. On March 9, 1948, Hermina was united in marriage with Dick L. Rozeboom. Together the couple farmed 4 years near Fairview, South Dakota, 9 years near Inwood, Iowa, and 28 years near Rock Valley, Iowa, before retiring to Rock Valley in 1990. Dick died February 15, 2001.

In addition to being a homemaker, Hermina drove school bus for the Netherlands Reformed Christian School for 20 years. She also volunteered many hours at the school as well as 6 years as a Foster Grandparent. Hermina was a member of the Netherlands Reformed Congregation and the Martha Mission Guild. Hermina passed away Wednesday, November 16, 2022, at Hegg Health Center in Rock Valley at the age of 96.
