- Delays in processing insolvencies, meaning clients are being hassled by creditors more than anyone wants
- Debt Transformation - bringing efficiencies to everyone's working

Current clients

- J&J - need to provide recent rent statement before next step can be taken
- ME - being so patient waiting for CAP to process her DRO and faithful in providing paperwork updates as needed.
- MT - courage/organisation to start paying in to plan, and commitment to see it through
- A - work is stressful. Work with CAP is ongoing and seeing results. She is planning a trip to her home country in July and is very much looking forward to it.
- N - pray for budgeting skills, and for son's (under 10) health as he has investigations
- R - essentially lost contact. Please pray for his mum, who is very supportive of R but also struggling to motivate him and feeling the stretch with increasing costs etc
- K - life continues to be very complicated for K. Mental health is poor, children need a lot of attention and CAP case is struggling through backlog
- S&M - new clients, due first appt on Tues

Not-yet clients (4 that I know of) and people who have actually referred themselves, but then said they don't need us for various reasons. Please pray that the little contact we have had will be the first step towards being released from the burden of debt, and towards an encounter with Jesus.
