Everett T. Tidwell, 90, resident of Madison, AL, formerly of Bowling Green and Clay, KY, passed away peacefully at Crestwood Medical Center in Huntsville, AL on September 30, 2009. He loved his church, Calvary Baptist Church in Bowling Green and was a faithful member until later years. He worked many jobs including Southern State and Frederick Lumber Company. He was looking forward to being inducted into the Hall of Heroes on November 10<sup>th</sup> for his service during the war.
