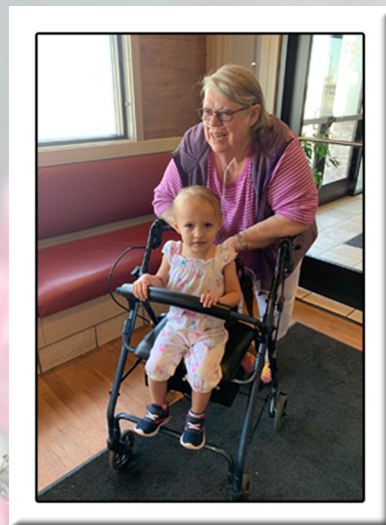


Rose Marie Johnson
