DIRECTORS INSTRUCTIONS

1. Drill Instructor for each Club will receive a little paper with a number that contain a list of Basic March steps. We will provide 5 different ways of executing the run commands. The marching instructor of the group will select a role with the steps he / she should carry out with his / her group.

2. Drill Instructor goes in front of judge making Hand Salute and saying: Permission to start routine, then awaits the answer of the judge: Permission granted; then make an about face and start routine with their group.

3. If you fail to follow the orders in sequence, you may lose points, because the judges can't keep up with all the steps.

4. Also you can watch the YouTube video named: NAD Pathfinder Drilling and Marching DVD preview. In this video you can learn the basics for Drilling and Marching rules. You can also call any Area Coordinator or Pathfinder Director (collins@upliftedcareservices.com) to help improve your performance skills on marching and drilling steps.

5. The command "Fall out" is an order to break formation but all pathfinders must remain within hearing distance of their instructor. Dismiss is the appropriate command to have the pathfinder team break formation and leave the premises.
