



7 - 9th Grade School Supply List (2020 - 2021)

- 4 spiral notebooks (100+ page count preferred; College Rule required. Please make sure all notebooks are hole-punched so that they can be stored inside a 3-ring binder.)
 - 1 red (Math)
 - 1 green (Science)
 - 1 blue (Social Studies)
 - 1 purple (English)
 - example:



- 4 folders (Hole-punched folders preferred so they can be stored inside a 3-ring binder.)
 - 1 red (Math)
 - 1 green (Science)
 - 1 blue (Social Studies)
 - 1 purple (English)
- 1 composition book of your choice (College Rule required)
 - example:



- 2 packs of #2 pencils
 - Ticonderoga pencils are recommended due to durability, but not required.
 - Students may use mechanical pencils with 0.7 mm HB lead if they prefer.
- erasers
- Crayola brand of colored pencils, crayons, markers
- highlighters (3 or 4 different colors required)

- ❑ 1 large, zip-up, 3-ring binder
 - ❑ The Case-it and Five Star zipper binders are popular choices. They can be purchased through Amazon or other retailers and are available in a variety of colors.
 - ❑ 3- or 4-inch binders (or bigger) are strongly recommended to ensure that all notebooks can fit inside.

- ❑ scientific calculator (A Casio fx-300ES calculator is shown below, but it does not have to be this specific model.)

- ❑ 1 pack of red-ink pens
- ❑ 1 ruler, 1 protractor, 1 compass
- ❑ loose-leaf lined paper (College Rule required)
- ❑ backpack, personal water bottle
- ❑ headphones
- ❑ face mask
- ❑ lanyard (recommended to clip on face mask and keep on person throughout the day)
- ❑ minimum of 2 tubs of Clorox/Lysol/disinfectant wipes
- ❑ minimum of 2 boxes of tissues
- ❑ minimum of 2 personal bottles of hand sanitizer
- ❑ packs of disposable water bottles
 - ❑ Please note that students will not be permitted to use the school water fountains at this time, so disposable water bottles will be used for refills as needed.
