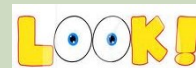

Gavin's favorite Bible text is John 3:16, because "it gives me an understanding of how much he loves me."

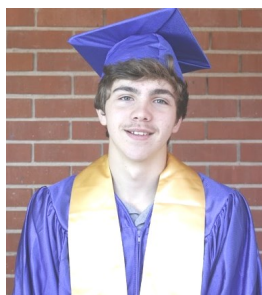
His best field trip memory will be made in April on the 8th grade class trip. His best APCS memory is the Fall Festivals because of the nice food and nice games.
