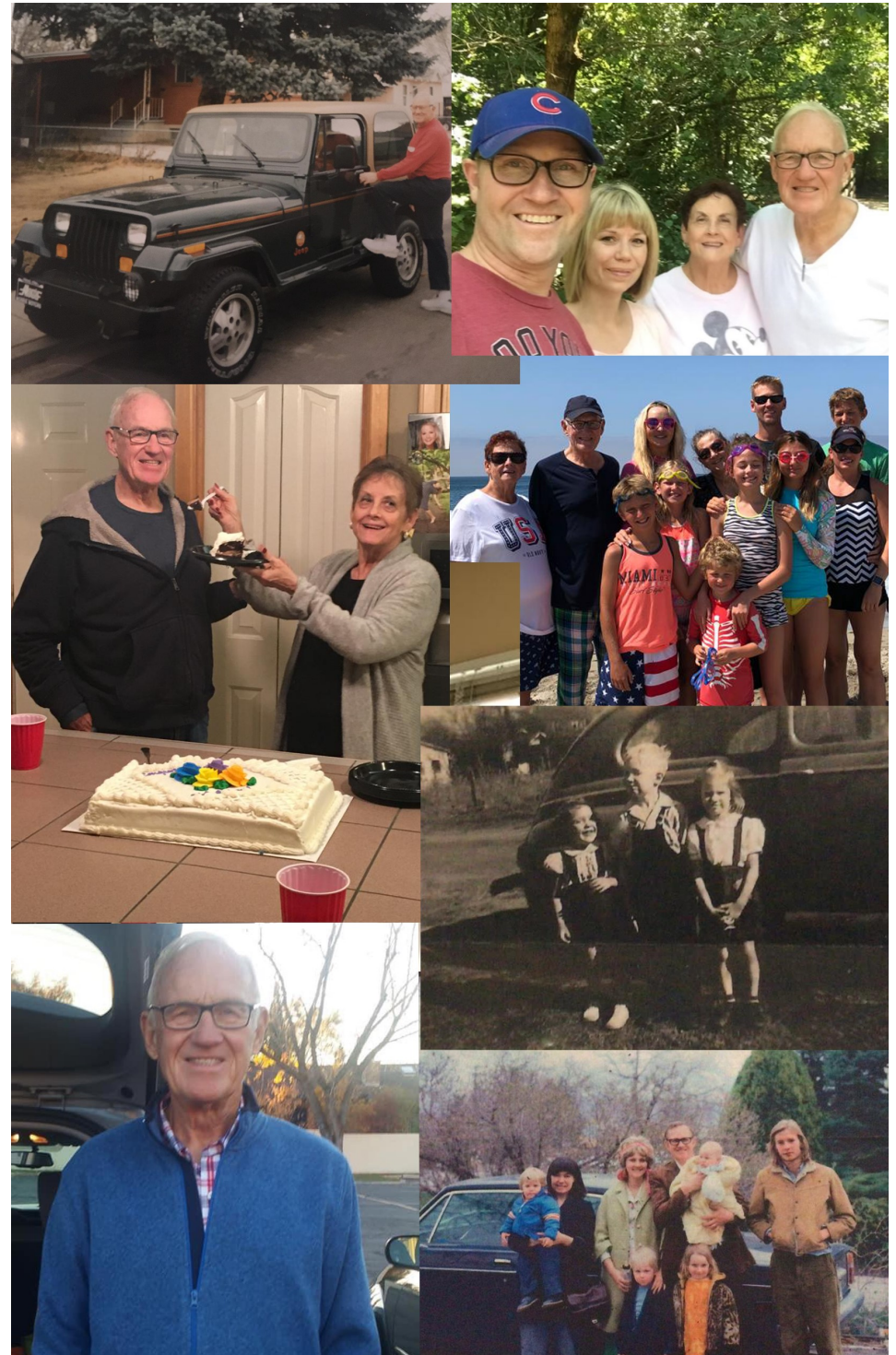


# In Loving Memory of Talo
