## Reflections of His Life

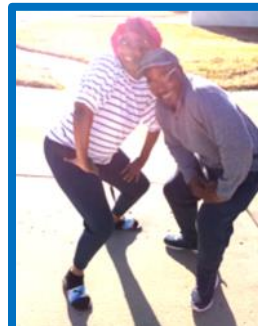
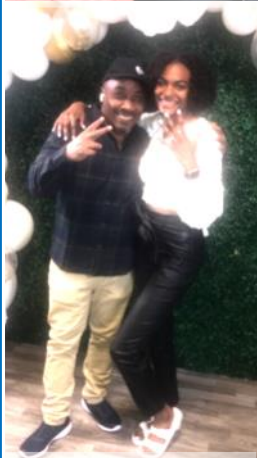
Patrick Glen Burton, was born on June 17, 1968 to L.C. Burton and Erma Jean York in Kansas City, Missouri.

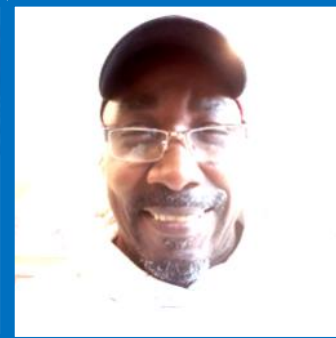
