of the Lord for ever.

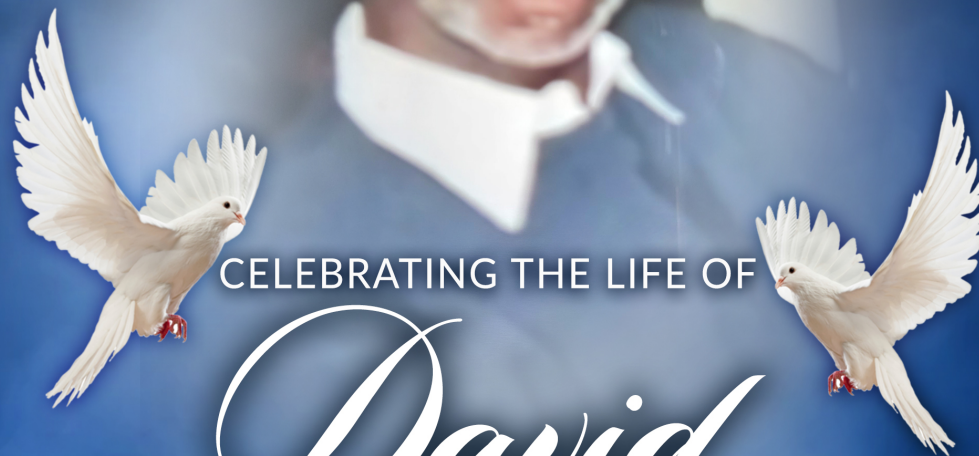

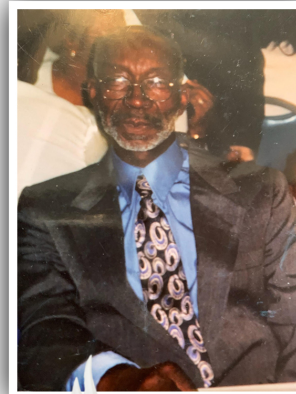
David, D.L., Pop, Pop Pop was and is still very loved by his family.
