Village Church Student Aid Philosophy

Christian education has been a core commitment of the Seventh-day Adventist Church since the early years of our history. As a denomination we believe it is vital to the training and nurture of young people. The Village Church affirms this tradition and stands with parents in their desire to educate their children in a God-honoring environment where Christian principles are esteemed and students are treated as God’s children. We believe that we have a responsibility to partner with parents and students who desire a Seventh-day Adventist Christian education. Funds generated by sales at the Village Church Center are dedicated to the Student Aid Scholarship Program. These funds are administered within the guidelines below.

Information Pertinent to Student Financial Assistance

1. Parents/guardians and/or students are attending members of the Village Church.
2. The parents/students should be regular tithe-returning members with the Village Church.
3. The portion of school account(s) not paid for by Student Aid must be kept current.
4. Students are expected to uphold school standards.
5. Academy students are encouraged to work and contribute to the payment of their school bill.
 - a. The Summer Work-Match Scholarship Program matches the student’s summer earnings up to \$1,250. (See Work-Match Application form)
 - b. The Village Church Work-Match Scholarship Program matches the student’s earnings throughout the school year up to \$250 per month. (See Work-Match Application form)

Application Guidelines for Student Financial Assistance

1. Complete and return this Student Financial Assistance Request Form to the Village Church Office by July 31.
2. After the Student Aid Committee reviews the request and determines eligibility, a link will be sent for the parents/guardians to complete the online FACTS Grant & Aid Application. (FACTS is an accurate, unbiased and confidential tool that assists in determining student assistance.)
3. When this application process is completed by July 31, the Student Aid Committee will notify the parents/guardians of the tuition assistance to be awarded before the beginning of the 2019/20 school year. Student Financial Assistance may, however, be requested at any time.
4. Funds are awarded year by year based on available resources.
5. Participating schools include Seventh-day Adventist conference-operated schools.
