### Ron Coggan

- SaSquash first tournament of the year; they had to cancel the tournament due to Omicron
  - The tournament typically sells out in a couple of hours
  - They had about 55 registered participants
    - Ron polled the entrants and several people dropped out due to Omicron and Injuries
    - Full refunds were provided and some offered to donate entry fee
  - People who still wanted to go to Banff were able to go out and they were still able to use the courts as they were all blocked off for the tournament
  - Al McAuley and Moustafa Khalid were the highest ranked players in the tournament
  - May do a summer SaSquash Tournament
    - Main purpose is to have fundraising for Bow Valley Squash Foundation
    - Money comes from fundraising, cash donations, sponsorship and the auction at the banquet
- Junior Outreach Squash Program relies on the fundraising of \$10,000 \$15,000
  - Restarted the program on November 4<sup>th</sup>
  - Cam Fishenden is the lead coach
  - Targeted the indigenous community for a pipeline of entrants
  - Something new has developed through Community Services in Banff that services Lake Louise, Canmore and Banff. The Community Services team reaches out to Refugees, Temporary Foreign Workers to help them get involved in the community and Junior Outreach Squash has seen a bump in entrants from this.
  - Program continues until the middle of March
  - Each week usually has 1 10 people that show up

## **b.** Committees

- Player Eligibility/ Reporting: Alex Altamirano
  - No penalty points have been administered and Alex has been checking Squash Alberta memberships
  - There has been some discretion applied to the Squash Alberta memberships; especially for people that are making efforts to get the membership right after
  - o Results getting into Squash Alberta relatively quickly and efficiently
  - Ensure that you rebook your matches scheduled (last two weeks of the season or any that have been cancelled due to COVID)
  - 10% of matches have been postponed or rescheduled (the bulk are with Bow Valley Club)
  - Issues reported around rescheduling matches with Bow Valley
  - Approximately 50% of players have signed the Squash Alberta COVID waiver

  - $\circ$   $\,$  Only have 2 months left to get your matches in
  - $\circ$   $\;$  Think outside the box when rescheduling (alternate evenings, other clubs etc.)
- No forfeits due to unwillingness to play, or inability to secure courts, until Omicron wave passes, and AHS Guidance is relaxed.

All Clubs Current Feedback

- Bow Valley Athletic Club
  - Not present
- Calgary Winter Club
  - Early January they had a rule for no guests at the club due to the omicron outbreak

  - Everything else is going well
- Edgemont Athletic Club
  - Everything is up and running
