

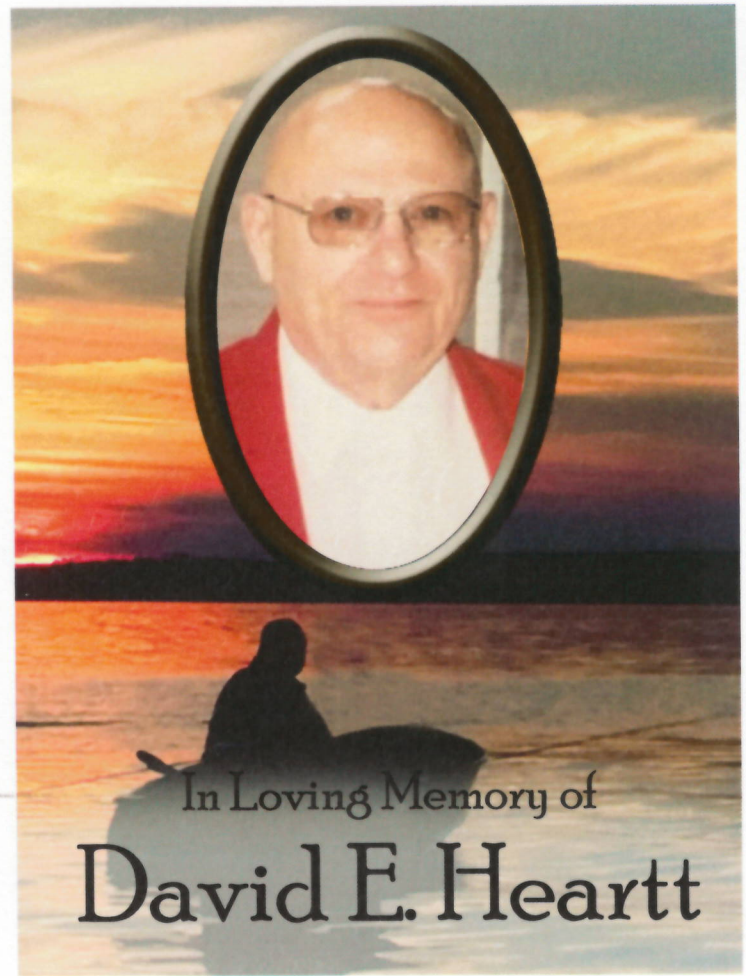
David Edwin Heartt, age 93, passed away at Brightondale Senior Living on June 25, 2021.
