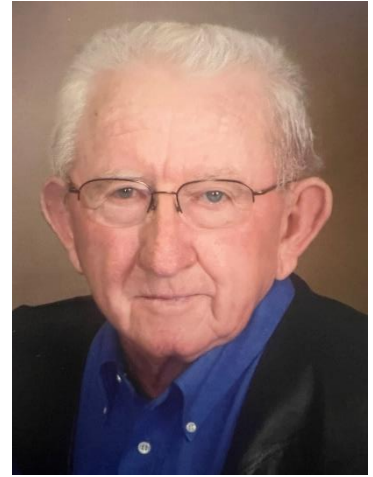


Mark J. Pinchart
