Maybe now in sunshine she can play.*

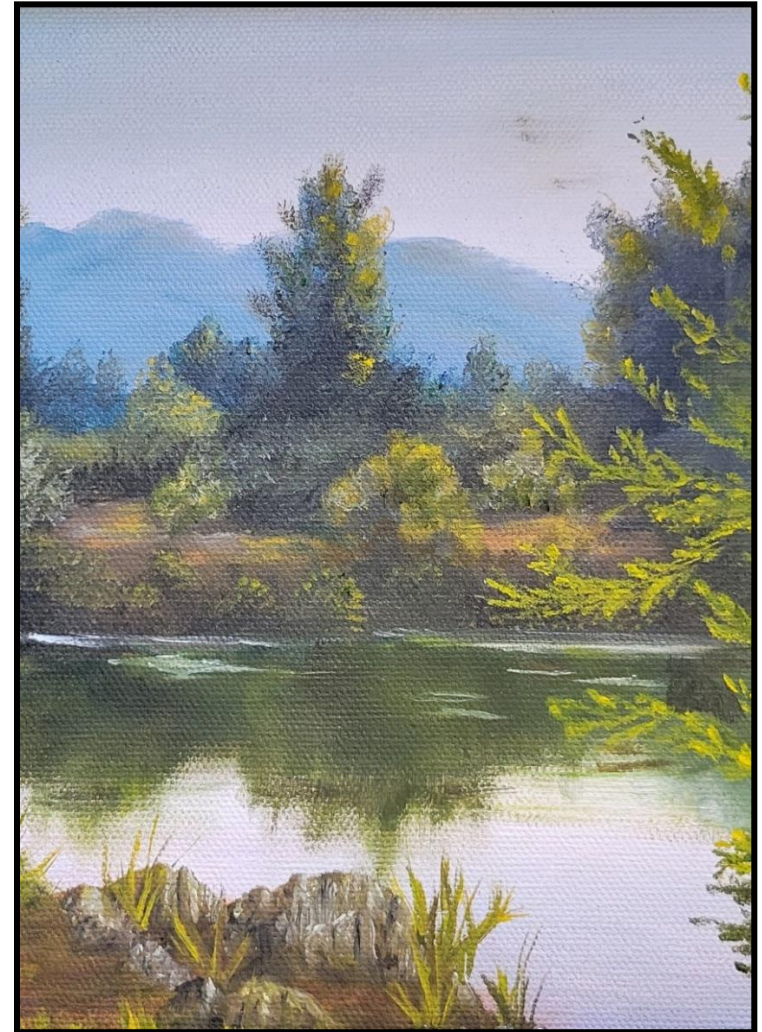
*Grandpa's gittin' thinner by the minute,
