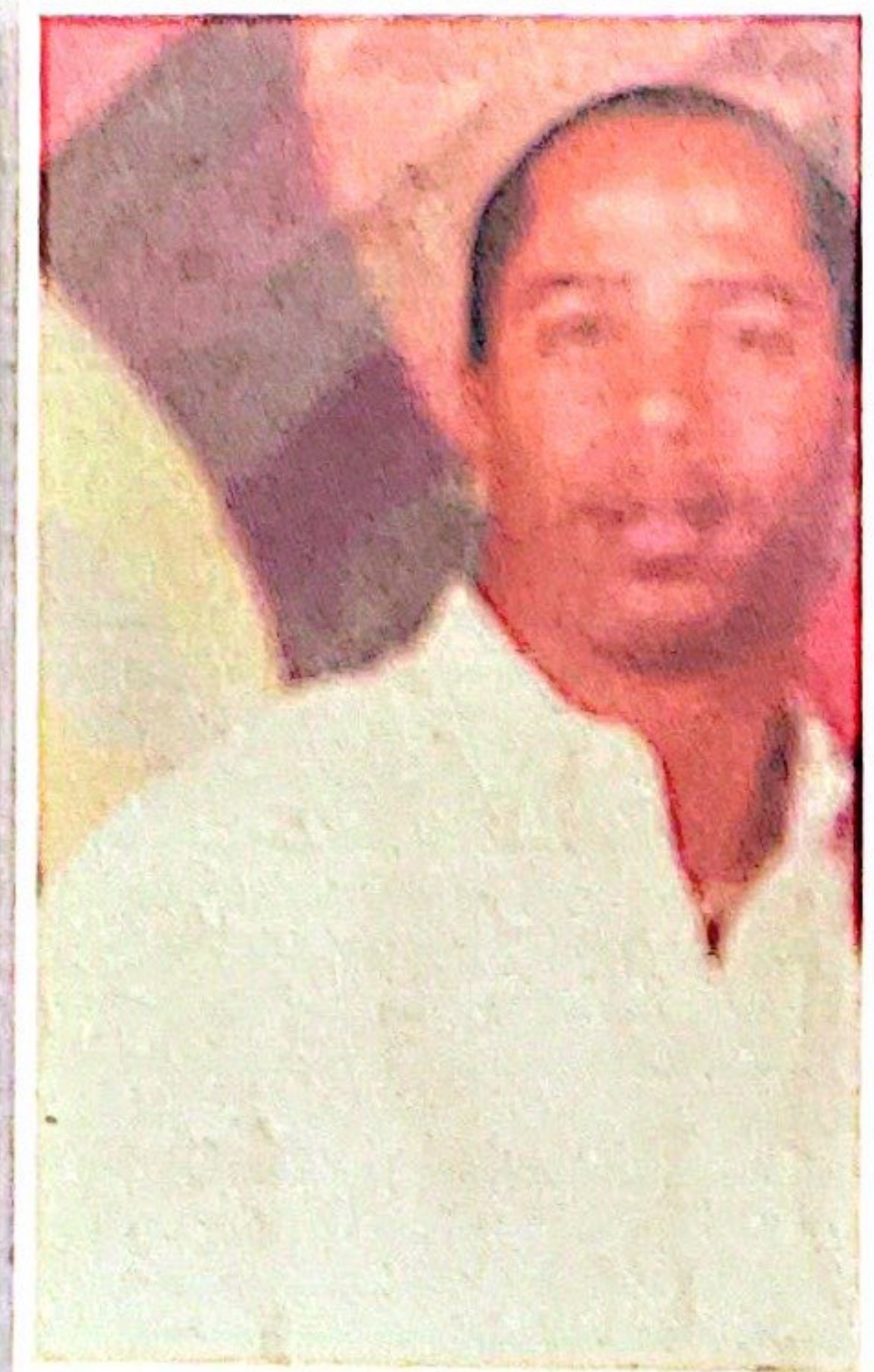
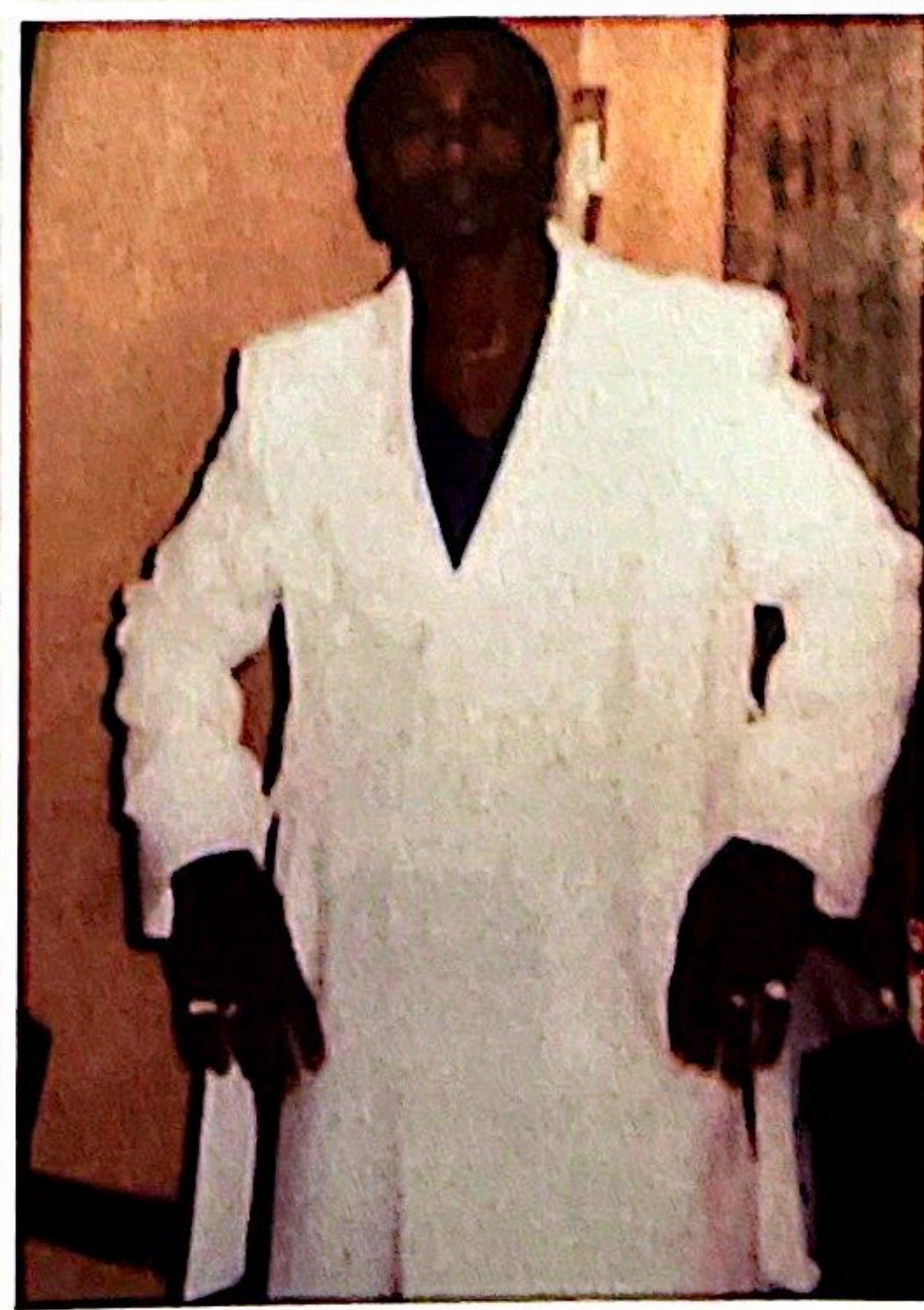
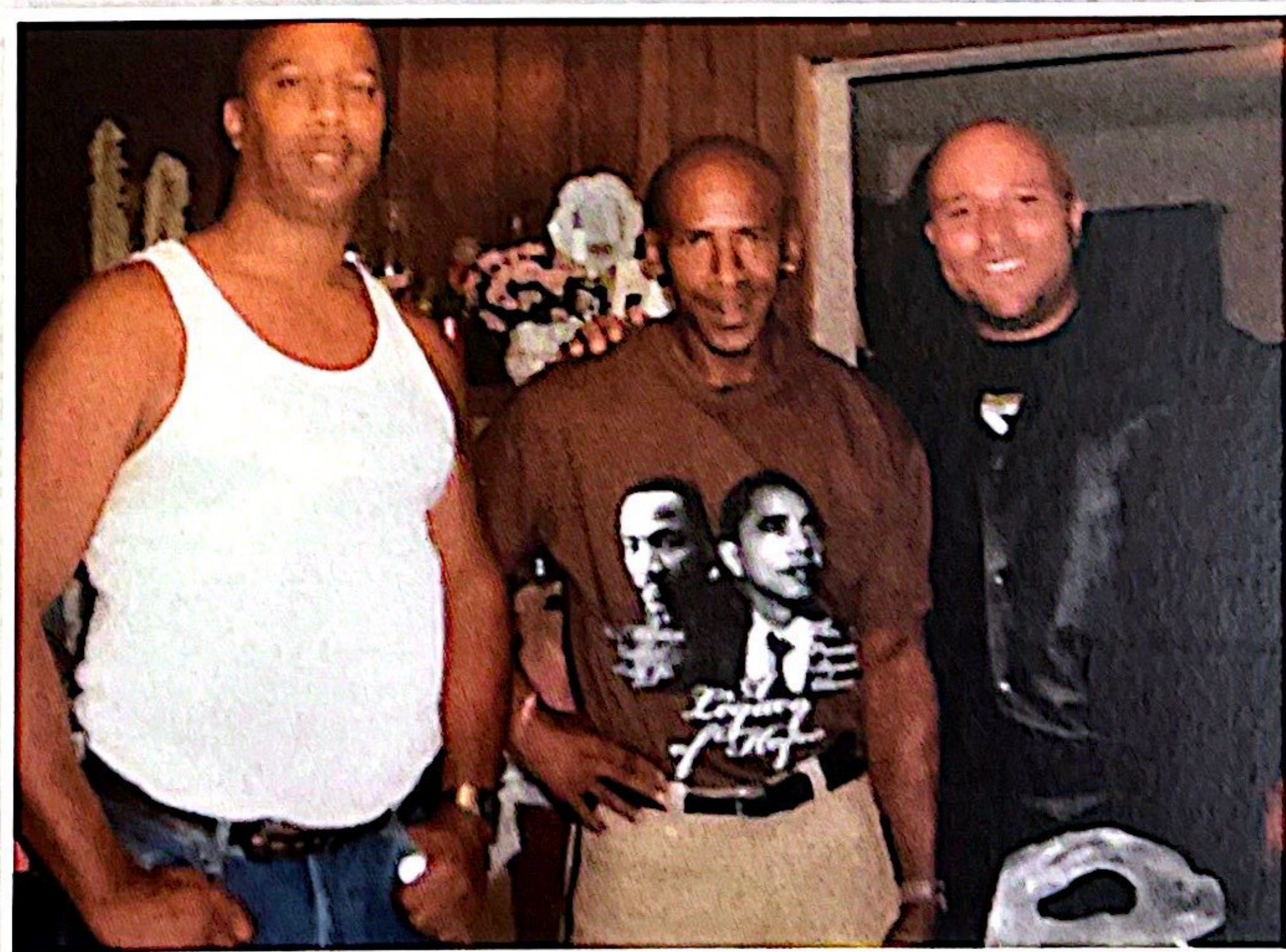
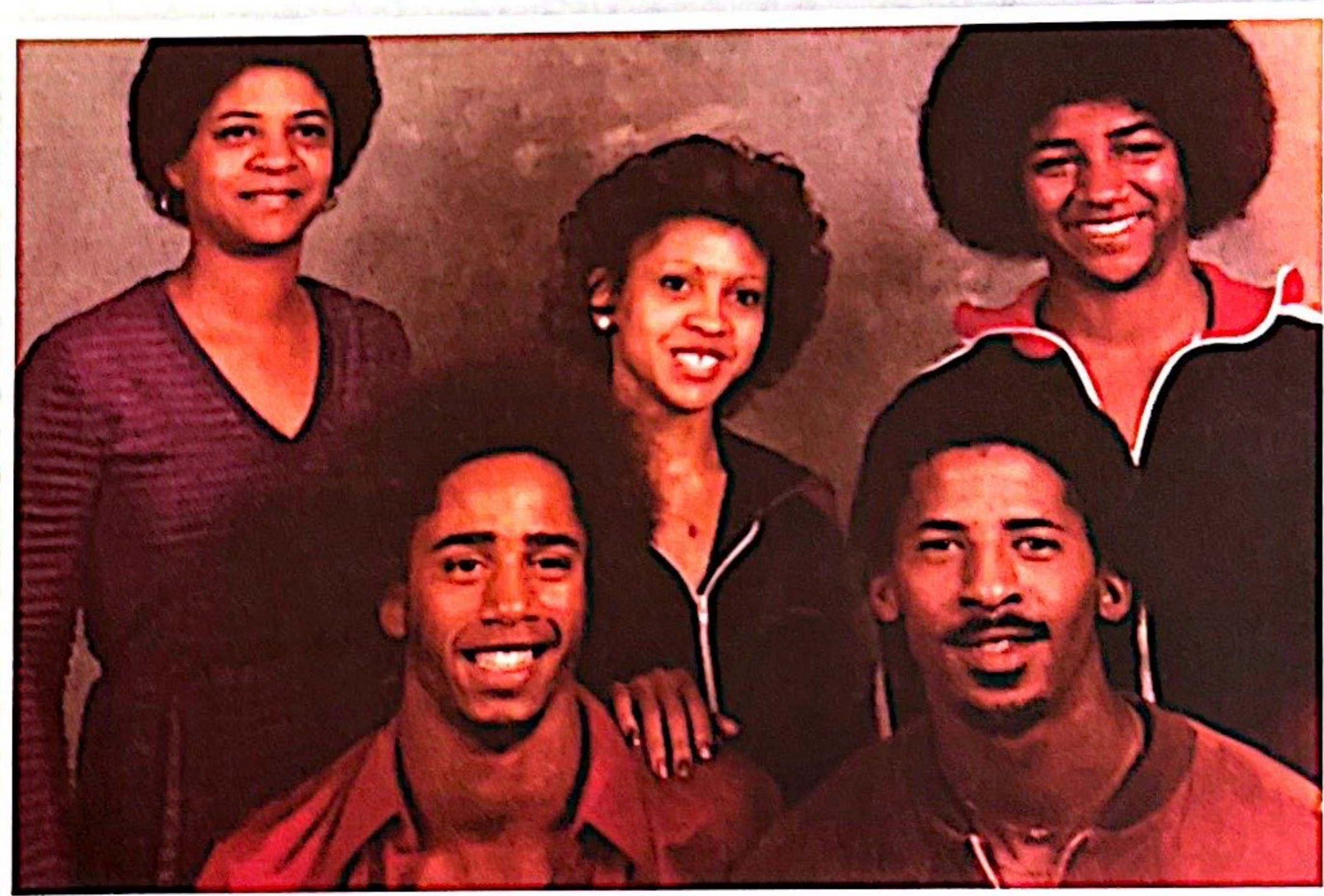
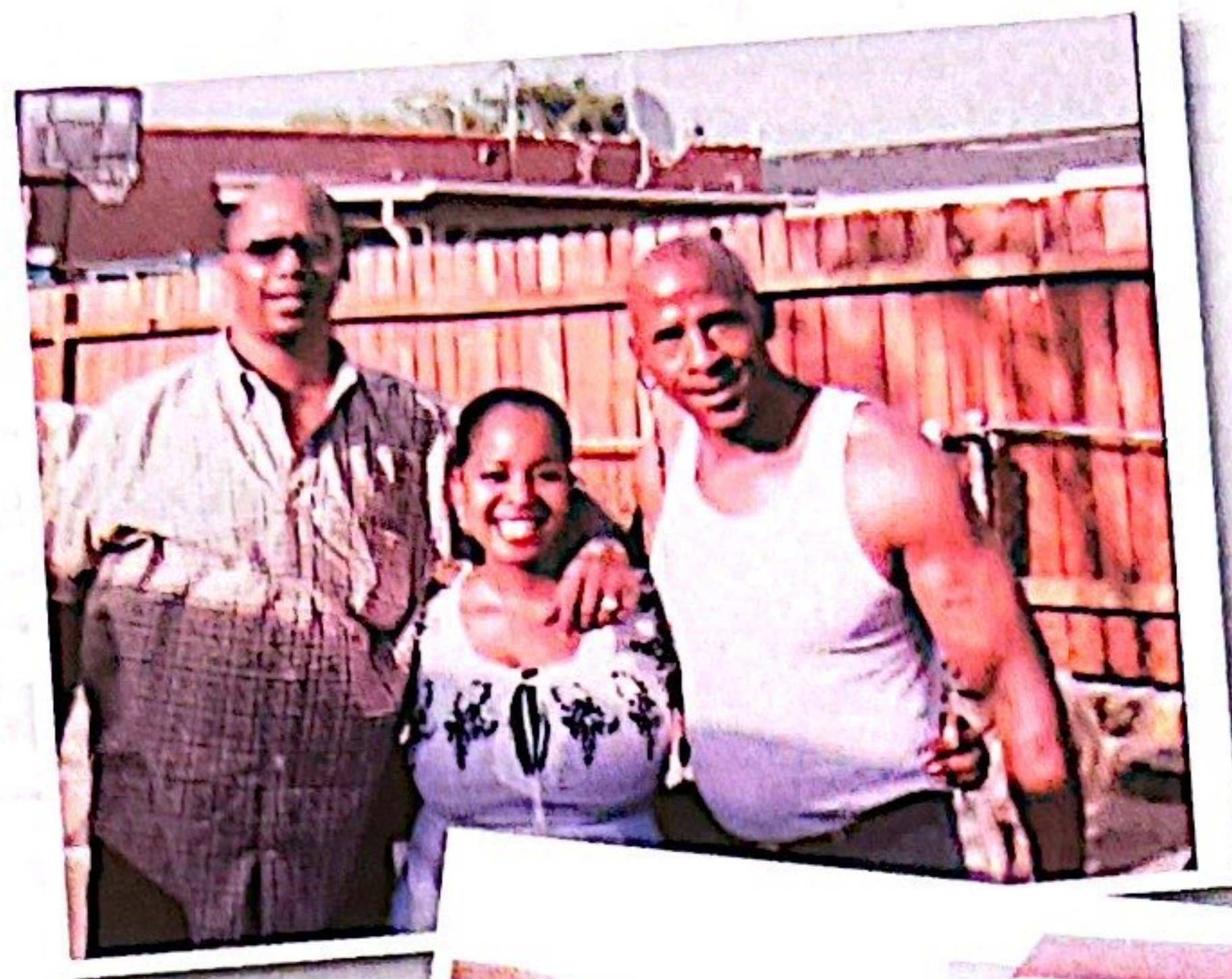
*Hey little brother, I saw

I must say that I'm grateful for the memories that we had. The times that we laughed, shared similar stories, jokes, and shed tears together.

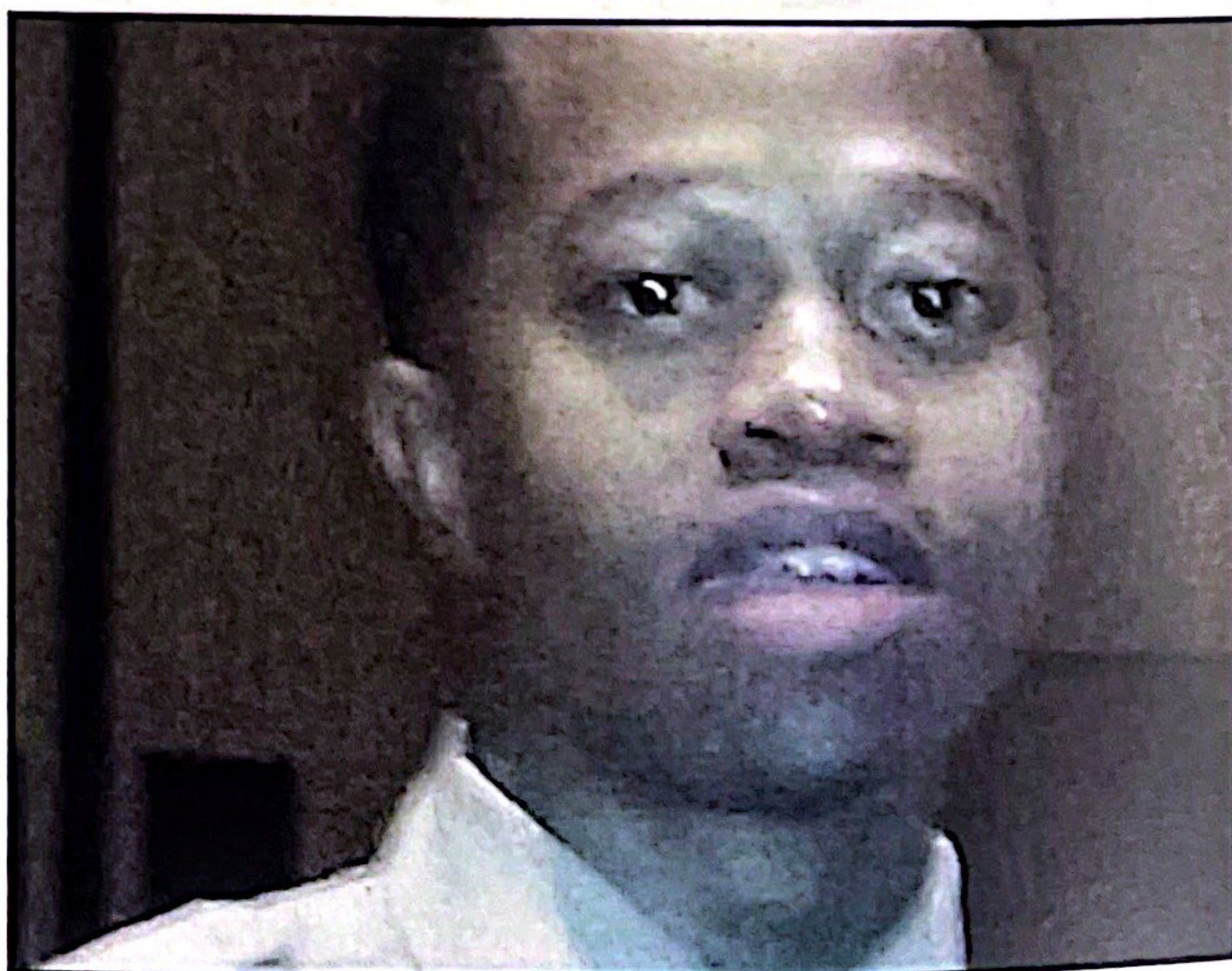
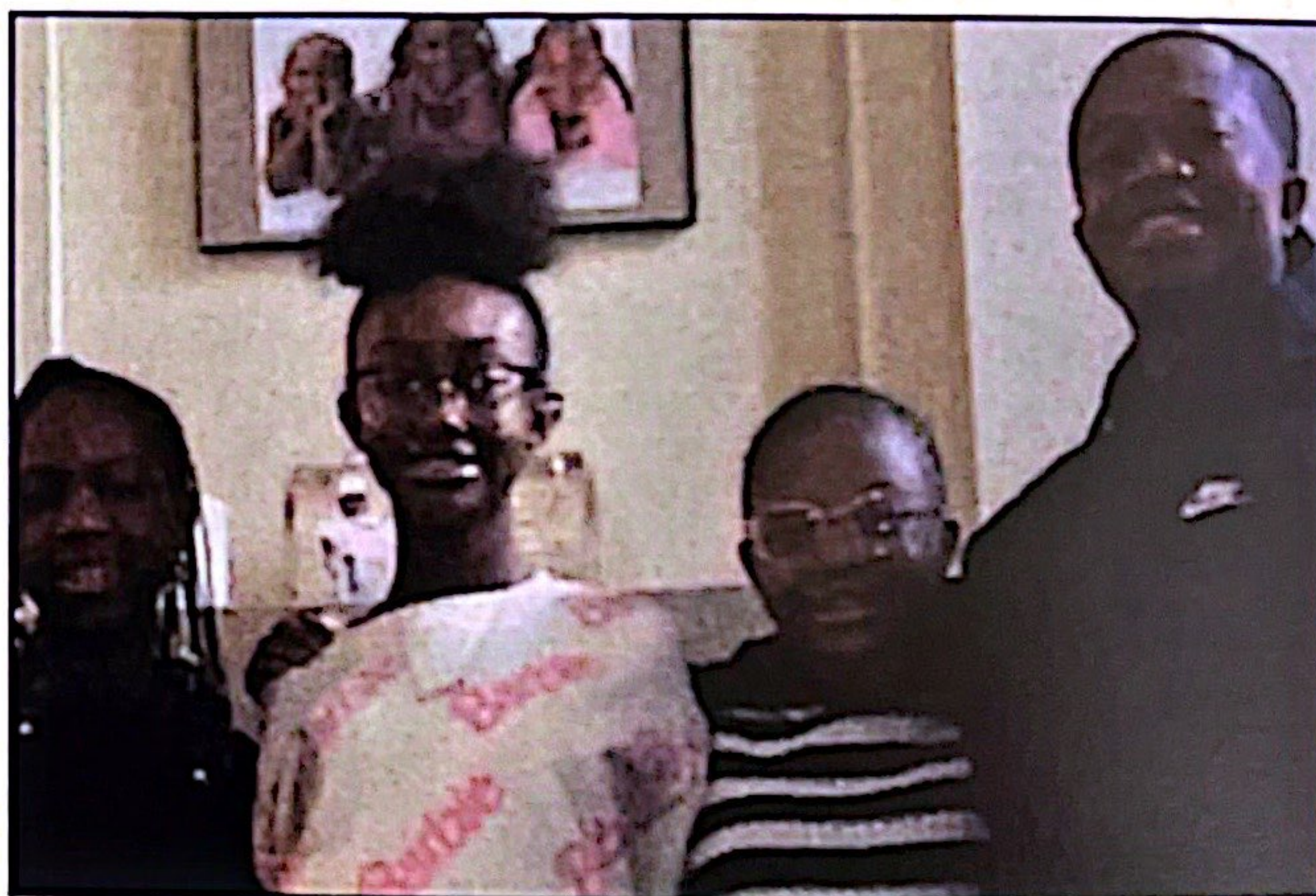
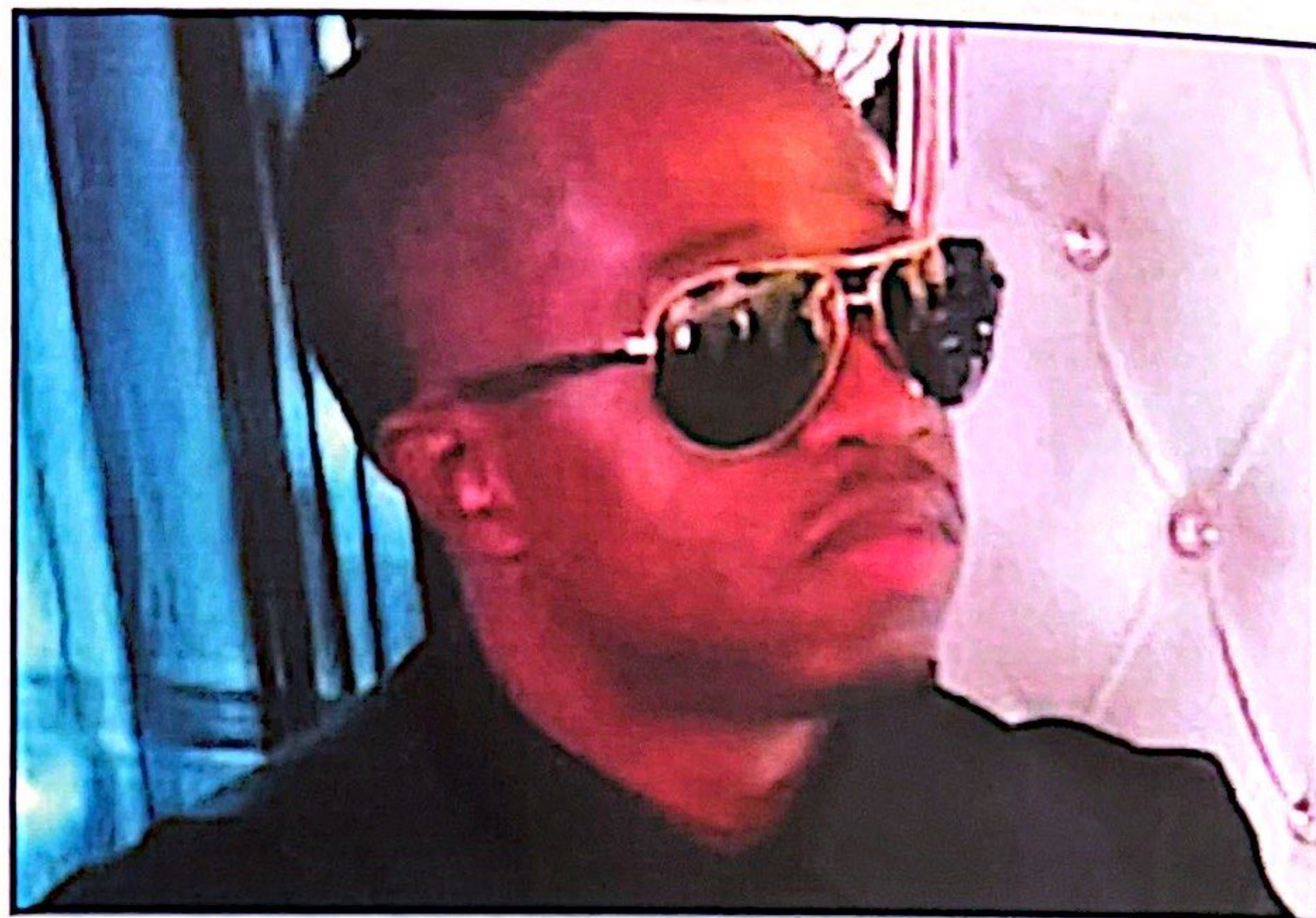
