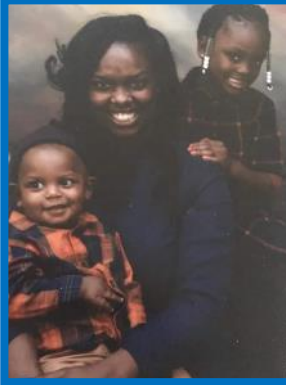

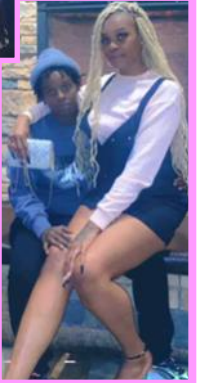
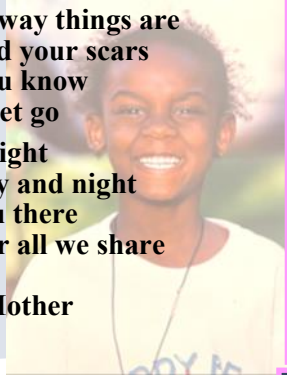
Our Love

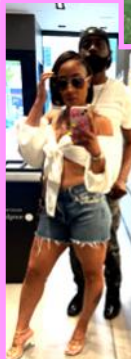


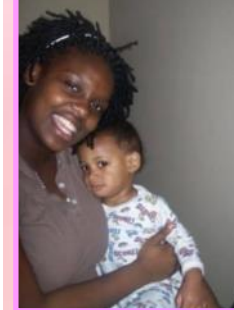
