

Nuvillo Gerald Bjork was born January 9, 1928, in Minneapolis, Minnesota to Walfred and Lydia Bjork. He lived in Minneapolis until he was 3 and then moved with his family to the farm in Sunburg. August Johnson became Nuvillo's caretaker when he was seven years old. Nuvillo attended District 17 country school and worked with August on the farm until he was drafted into World War II. By the time he enlisted, the war was over, so he worked several odd jobs until he left to serve in the Korean War in November 1950. He served his country in the 24th Infantry of the Army, attained rank of Master Sergeant and was honorably discharged 1952.

Nuvillo married Jane Fossen on February 17, 1953, in Elk Point, South Dakota. They moved in with August and purchased the farm from August when he was no longer able to do the work. Nuvillo grew corn and beans, had dairy and beef cattle and pigs. He worked very hard and loved the work he did on the farm. He enjoyed spending time at Norway Lake and he and Jane were able to take several trips once they retired from farming in early 1990's. Nuvillo and Jane were able to live on the farm until June of this year. He enjoyed watching the garden grow and the many visits from family each week.
