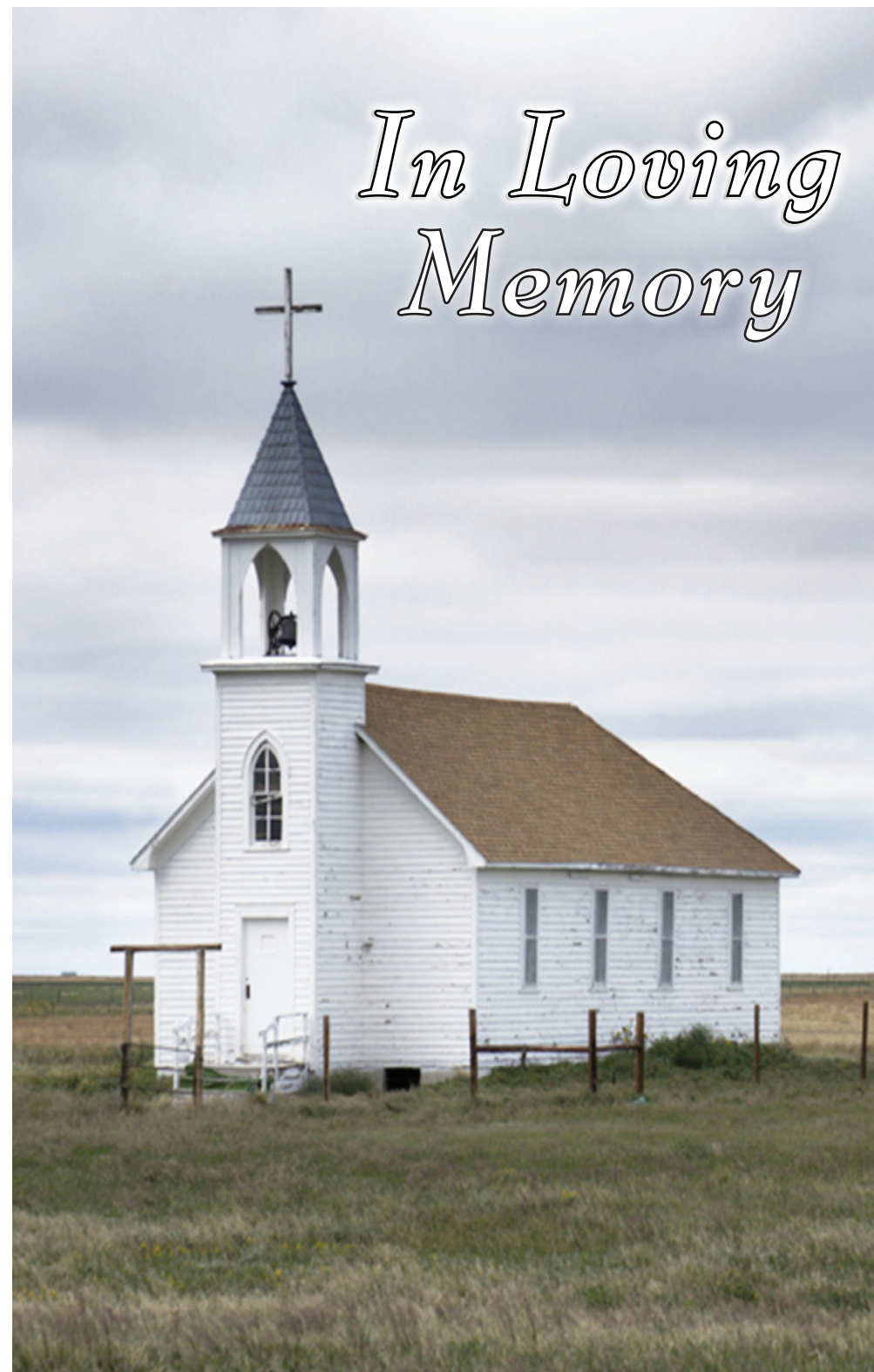


*Remember O most loving Virgin Mary,
