

Squash ACT Juniors: Governance Structure

- 1. The ACT Junior Program will consist of three activities:
 - i. ACT Junior Pennant
 - ii. ACT Junior Pennant Training
 - iii. ACT Junior Representative Team/Squad (AJC and AJO)
- 2. The staffing structure for the Program is:
 - i. ACT Juniors Program Manager (Anthony Ricketts)
 - ii. ACT Juniors Squash Head Coach (Peter Nuttall)
 - iii. ACT Pennant Coordinator (Russell Weatherburn)
 - iv. ACT Juniors Assistant Coaches (Liam Schneck, Nathan Rogan)
- 3. The governance structure for the administration and development of junior squash in the ACT is as follows:

Board

- Appoints Juniors Program Manager;
- Oversees financial management of ACT Junior Program;
- Approves and develops junior-related policy;
- Oversees and provides guidance on issues that fall within Member Protection matters;
- Assists and arbitrates as required in dispute resolution; and,
- Provides the Appeals Committee Chair for ACT representative teams.

ACT Juniors Program Manager

- Reports to Board;
- Manages coaching appointments and mentoring of coaches;
- Oversees the delivery of ACT Junior Pennant and Representative Teams (AJC and AJO);
- Chair of the selection committee for ACT representative teams;
- Member of the Appeals Committee for ACT representative teams;
- Liaises with Squash Australia on matters relating to High Performance;
- Oversees ad hoc tasks that accompany the delivery of the junior program (policies, uniforms, fund raising, tournament organisation); and,
- Chairs the Squash ACT Junior ranking panel (ranking lists will be published two times per year: immediately following AJO, and immediately following AJC).

ACT Juniors Head Coach

- Reports to Juniors Program Manager;
- Head Coach of ACT Junior Representative Teams (AJO and AJC);
- Assists the Juniors Program Manager with oversight of ACT Junior Representative Teams;
- Assists the Juniors Program Manager with the oversight and delivery of Junior Pennant;
- Mentors the Juniors Assistant Coaches;
- Manages communications relating to the Squash ACT Junior Program;
- Undertakes duties and responsibilities as the Head Coach of ACT Junior Representative teams;
- Member of the selection committee for ACT representative teams and Junior Squads;
- Directs and mentors the Junior Assistant Coaches;
- Administers the Barbara de Bruin Award, in conjunction with the Program Manager and Juniors Assistant Coaches; and,
- Member of ACT Juniors ranking system panel.

ACT Pennant Coordinator

- Reports to Juniors Program Manager;
- Administers SportyHQ functions (Pennant draws and tournament draws);
- Member of the Selection Committee for ACT representative teams; and,
- Member of the ACT Junior ranking system panel.

ACT Juniors Assistant Coaches

- Reports to Juniors Head Coach and, as required, Program Manager;
- Administers the delivery of Saturday Junior Pennant;
- Administers the delivery of the optional Junior Pennant activities (mid-week training sessions);
 and,
- Supports Juniors Head Coach in preparation and coaching of ACT Junior representative teams.
