

Last Reunion

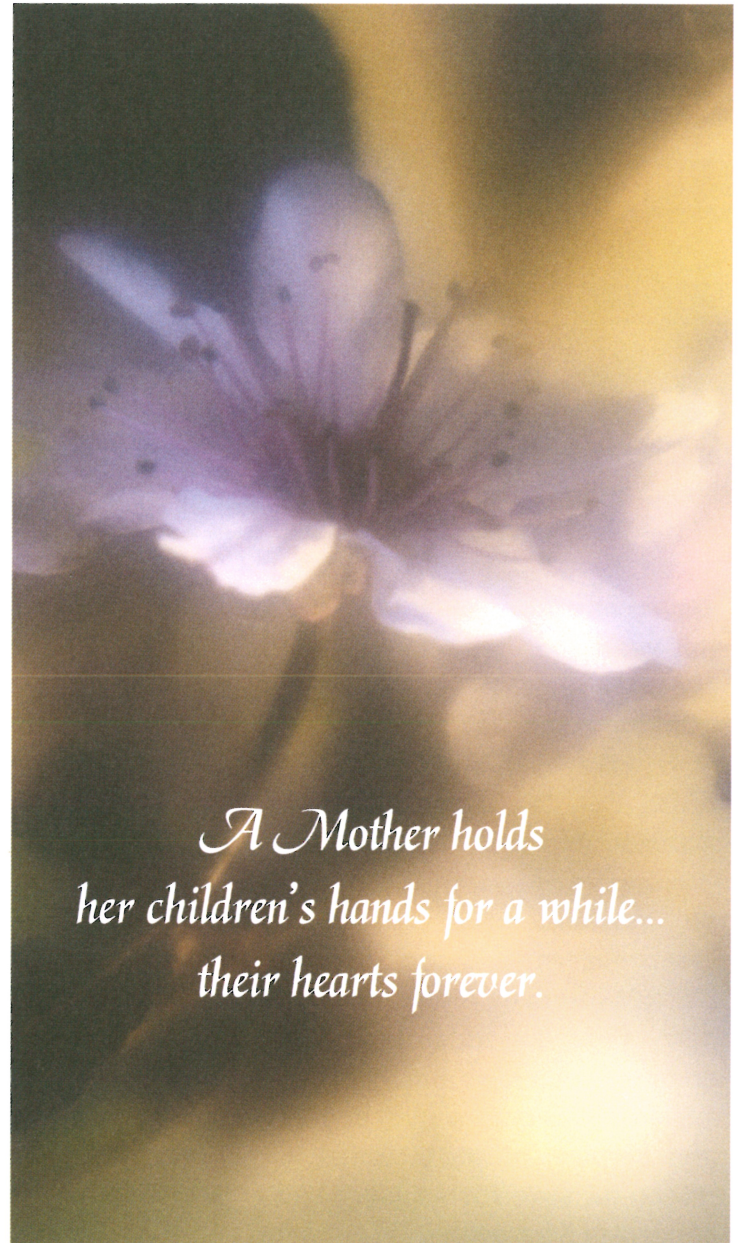
When my life's last page is written
