The tournament will be run as graded dependent on skill levels. All players guaranteed three matches where possible.

The tournament will be held under the rules of the GAME, and subject to the Conditions and Regulations of the TOURNAMENT COMMITTEE.

### TOURNAMENT RULES AND CONDITIONS

- All entries must be made on the prescribed form and must be accompanied by the relevant fee. Draw and 1<sup>st</sup> round matches on web site from Thursday evening (17th Sept). <http://www.tas.squash.org.au/wl/masters/tournaments>
- The Masters Championships shall be open to players who have attained the prescribed age on or before 18 Sept 2020.
- All matches shall be played at times and dates to be notified in the draws. The Tournament Committee reserves the right to disqualify any competitor who has not reported to the Control Desk at least **15 minutes** prior to the advertised starting time of his/her event.
- On completing his/her match, **each player** will be responsible for either marking or refereeing the following match on the court on which he/she played.
- The Tournament Committee reserves the right to refuse the entry of any person and shall not be required to assign any reason for so doing, and may at its discretion vary any or all of the conditions.
- No claims whatsoever will be recognised should any player receive injury whilst participating in the Championships.
- Tournament ball will be a Dunlop double dot although a single dot can be used if both players agree.
- Tournament scoring will be Point A Rally (PAR) 15. or PAR 11 for top grades at the Tournament Director's discretion.

Friday night matches will only be scheduled if necessitated by the number of entries.
