Thanks and Farewell

It's with a heavy heart and overwhelming gratitude that we farewell our Executive Officer of 2.5 years, valued board director and dear friend - Colette Sultana.

Colette joined Squash Queensland in July 2019 with the objective of overseeing our operations, strengthen relations with government, increase funding, better support clubs and centres, build membership confidence, improve affiliation benefits, and increase participation. And, under Colette's determined and steady management, has left a great legacy

- Successive representations to the Minister and the department of Sport & Recreation have strengthened our standing in the State sporting landscape.
- In conjunction with Squash Australia, we are confident of increase core funding and supplementary grant opportunities as we stare down the Olympics in 2032. Our financial viability is all the more assured by Colette's tireless work.
- We have surveyed and consulted players, clubs and centres to better understand their challenges in order to better support their business delivery, especially through COVID-19.
- Club memberships have increased almost 5 fold to 45 member clubs around the state. There is an identified need for centres (without clubs) to be better serviced under our umbrella.
- Player memberships increased 100% to almost 2000 members (since impacted by COVID-19; Our members now enjoy unprecedented benefits though their affiliation, including enhanced insurance, one stop info via SportyHQ, connecting via SquashLab App, 10% discount with Quest Hotel, discount fuel with Freedom; 30% redemption with Dulux and more.
- Participation has increased commensurate with affiliation, but work is continuing how to reach the more than 30,000 casual players, with an eye on introducing juniors to squash through Sporting Schools and national marketing with Squash Australia.

In her dual executive and board roles, Colette has advised the Board on the strategic direction, chaired our Participation subcommittee, co-ordinated regions and clubs, directed championship tournaments, and shared valuable insight as a professional player in her own right.

We thank and congratulate Colette for her passion, resilience and contribution to the sport, and wish her all the very best in her new phase of professional and business life.

Lead by Colette, we have worked hard to continue to improve Squash Queensland's relationship with state government and prospects of funding for future years. Although we have yet to reap financial rewards in the form of government funding, Colette (in partnership with our affiliated clubs) has successfully managed current state government funding to facilitate:

 10 Get Active Open Days around the state of QLD, reaching thousands of new, casual players with the opportunity to access free squash and physical activity opportunities.

- 7 School or Holiday Programs around QLD reaching over 200 children around the state.
- Referee Education and Support program that was available to all affiliated player members. 35 candidates around QLD furthered their rules of squash knowledge (thanks to the volunteer assistance of Nathan Turnbull); a number of who went on to become certified referees.
- 11 Junior LEARN To PLAY Squash Programs that brought 206 new children to the sport of squash.
- Delivery of 2 state camps reaching over 100 developing and elite level players in QLD.
- Delivery of the QJC and QOpen (also during the pandemic), with excellent participation levels, given the circumstances.
- New sponsors and partners for QLD state teams and other deals and benefits for our Player and Centre affiliates.



QMSA CORNER








