1. Facility CRM

Squash Australia is in the process of updating their facility CRM through documents dedicated to new facility developments, lease/purchase opportunities and renovations tasks. Additionally, SQA's facility information database is also being updated through contact with every squash facility nationwide with the resulting outcome to be able to create current supply & demand heatmaps for states and LGA's.

Any facility State Associations that can provide on squash facilities in their State is welcomed.

2. University Conference

Squash Australia will attend the National University Conference in May (Melbourne). The aim of the conference is to network and share marketing collateral around multi-functional squash courts spaces, participation programmes and to spread the word of the new 'Squash Girls Can' university initiative.

3. Parks & Leisure Conference

Occurring in Perth during October, Squash Australia would aim to present at the National Parks & Leisure Conference with the main talking point being the outdoor squash court concept.

4. Facility Strategy

Over the next three months Squash Australia will finalise the strategy for approaching Private Lifestyle, Public, individually owned and Education facilities.

Next, we will work with the States to develop State by State Facility plans which will form a National Facility plan that we can provide to Sport Australia and State Departments to ensure resources are focused where the sport needs them.
