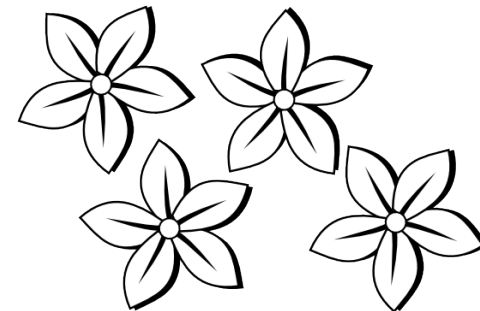
Volunteers Needed: "Love Heals" Free Clinic Event April 18-19
