

Dear Medical Volunteer,

Thank you for your interest in volunteering for the 2019 Chosen International Pathfinder Camporee in Oshkosh, Wisconsin. The time is fast approaching and as we get closer things will speed up and we will need lots of hands to complete much work. I look forward to working with you again or for the first time. Here is some basic information that I hope will answer your questions. Feel free to contact me with any additional questions and start to read the Camporee newsletters as they come out because information will start to come fast and frequent.

Here is some basic information:

- We will need volunteers beginning on the Sunday before the official start of the camporee and through the Sunday after camporee ends.
- We will need help in setting up the medical building, sorting supplies, and being available to provide medical care to the volunteers who are setting up.
- The Medical Team will be comprised of:
 - Doctors
 - Nurse Practitioners
 - Physician Assistants
 - Nurses (RN/LPN)
 - EMT
 - Paramedics
 - Certified Nursing Assistants
 - Dentists
 - Support staff
 - Golf cart transport driver
 - Van driver to town and back
 - Others as needed
- The medical building will be staffed 24/7. (Subject to change as we get closer)
- I will do my best to work the schedule to meet everyone's needs and requests and ensure that everyone gets to the evening programs as much as possible.
- Golf carts will be available for the Paramedic/EMT teams to roam the grounds and respond to scene needs. These will be assigned by the EMS coordinator team.
- Golf cart available for Dr. Mayor and Pamela Krueger.
- Radio sign out will be managed differently than in past years – stay tuned for more information to follow.
- Everyone must have a current license for your specialty for the state in which you are currently employed.
- You must be licensed in the United States.

- You do not need a Wisconsin license for your specialty. Because we are volunteering we are covered.
- Please make sure that you complete a volunteer application on the website and purchase a ticket.
- I will need your scrub top size eventually.
- Please subscribe to the [online newsletter](#) as more information will be coming out via the newsletter and as we get closer it will come fast and furious.
- Please let me know if you are coming only as a volunteer or if you will also have club responsibilities well in advance so we don't have schedule surprises.
- Each camporee has had its own problems – constipation because of the fear of using port-o-lets; heat related issues, asthma, and cold temperatures.
- If you are the medical support person for your particular club we will look to you to help manage your club issues/injuries as best as possible and the medical building is always available.
- If you have special supplies/equipment please feel free to bring them but we cannot be responsible for storing or ensuring that they are kept safe.
