Reminder

Cooler Weather - Cooler weather means that students need to wear a jacket or a sweatshirt to school. Please take note, students can wear any color outer jacket or sweatshirt to school (No Logos), but in the classroom the required sweater is Navy Blue!

Weather Alerts - DAS would like to advise you that we monitor inclement weather coming to Florida. Please be advised that if Volusia County Schools are closed due to any storms, the Deltona Adventist School will monitor the storm closely to decide school closing. Due to any adverse weather or emergencies, we may require school having an early dismissal or closing. Additionally, DAS officials will use the automated telephone message system to announce closing, delays, and updated information. The absence of any announcement means that school will operate regularly. If students are dismissed early due to the weather, please know that there will be NO after-care program. At all times we take the safety of our students and staff as our priority.

Uniforms - Just a quick reminder of our school policy. Our students are to wear navy or grey uniform shirts with school logo, black belts, navy blue, white or grey socks, sneakers that are **ALL** black, and khaki or navy-blue skirts, pants, shorts or shorts. For P.E. black basketball shorts and grey P.E. shirts. Please take note that the field trip t-shirts

are navy blue, not grey P.E. shirts. If you do choose to layer under your child's polo shirt, please choose the school's color, navy or grey. Please, parents check your child to make sure they are in full compliance with the school's dress code policy.
