






St James Muswell Hill Easter Story Trail



Muswell Hill
2-11 April 2021

Enjoy a short walk around Muswell Hill to find the clues about the story of the first Easter and use a mobile device (requires data usage) to watch the characters retelling the story by scanning the QR codes at each stop.

On each page there are these symbols:

-  Watch the character retell part of the Bible story
-  Find the clue on the poster to answer the question
-  Directions for the route

Station 1: The Birchwood Centre



Scan the QR code to watch a member of the crowd describe Jesus coming into Jerusalem on Palm Sunday.

You can find this story in the second half of the Bible (the New Testament) in a book called Matthew chapter 21 verses 1-11 and Luke chapter 19 verses 28-44.



Look at clue on the poster.

What did the crowd wave as Jesus entered Jerusalem?

Write or draw it below.



To get to the next story station, walk along Fortis Green Road towards St James Church. The next clue is in the front garden.

Station 2: St James Muswell Hill



Scan the QR code to watch Judas agree to betray Jesus.

You can find this story in the second half of the Bible (the New Testament) in a book called Matthew chapter 26 verses 14-16 and Luke chapter 22 verses 1-6.



Look at clue on the poster.

What did Judas get for agreeing to betray Jesus?

Write or draw it below.



Head down St James' Lane to the Vicarage car park.

Station 3: The Vicarage



Scan the QR code to watch James, one of Jesus' disciples, describe the Last Supper.

You can find this story in the second half of the Bible (the New Testament) in a book called Matthew chapter 26 verses 17-30 and Luke chapter 22 verses 7-23.



Look at clue on the poster.

What did Jesus use to remind us of his body and blood?

Write or draw it below.



Head down St James' Lane to the next house, 8 St James' Lane.

Station 4: 8 St James' Lane



Scan the QR code to watch Peter, one of Jesus' disciples, describe Jesus' arrest and his denial.

You can find this story in the second half of the Bible (the New Testament) in a book called Matthew chapter 26 verses 31-75 and Luke chapter 22 verses 31-62.



Look at clue on the poster.

What did the soldiers bring with them to arrest Jesus?

Write or draw it below.



Head further down St James' Lane to 20 St James' Lane.

Station 5: 20 St James' Lane



Scan the QR code to watch Pilate share what he thought of Jesus.

You can find this story in the second half of the Bible (the New Testament) in a book called Matthew chapter 27 verses 11-26 and Luke 22: 66-23:25.



Look at clue on the poster.

What did Pilate do to show he didn't want to be blamed for Jesus' punishment?

Write or draw it below.



Head further down St James' Lane to 67 St James' Lane.

Station 6: 67 St James' Lane



Scan the QR code to watch the Roman Centurion share what he thought of Jesus' crucifixion.

You can find this story in the second half of the Bible (the New Testament) in a book called Matthew chapter 27 verses 45-56 and Luke chapter 23 verses 26 - 49.



Look at clue on the poster.

We use this symbol to represent Christianity as a reminder of how Jesus died.

Write or draw it below.



Continue to 76 St James' Lane to 3 View Cottages on the right before NLPAC.

Station 7: 3 View Cottages, 76 St James' Lane



Scan the QR code to hear what Mary found when she arrived at the tomb.

You can find this story in the second half of the Bible (the New Testament) in a book called Matthew chapter 28 verses 1-10 and Luke chapter 24 verses 1-12.



Look at clue on the poster.

What did Mary find when she reached the tomb?

Write or draw it below.

↑ Go back up St James' Lane to the viaduct and go up the steps to join the Parkland Walk. At the top of the steps, turn right towards Cranley Gardens. At the end, go along Woodside Avenue to St James CE School.

Station 8: St James CE Primary School



Scan the QR code to hear how Thomas, one of Jesus' disciples, went from doubt to belief.

You can find this story in the second half of the Bible (the New Testament) in a book called Luke chapter 24 verses 36-49.



Look at clue on the poster.

What did Thomas see that changed his mind to believe that Jesus really had come back to life?

Write or draw it below.



This is the end of the trail. To get back to the start of the route, cross opposite the school and walk through the housing development, cross Grand Avenue, going up Birchwood Ave.
