I just can't ignore.**

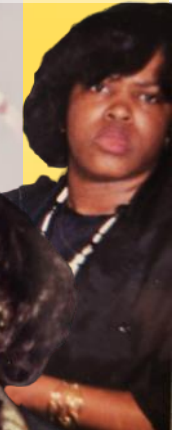
**The nights are sleepless,

I'll never give up or ever let go

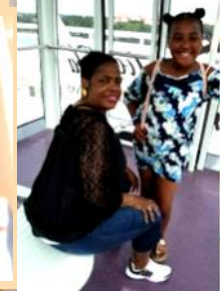
Even when you're not in sight
