Wow! Bible has really come alive this week. We studied Nebuchadnezzar's dreams and their interpretations. We learned about the history of Babylonia and Babylon during the 600-500's BC. We looked at pictures of historical artifacts and of Babylon itself. We talked about how history plays a part of the interpretations of the dreams and where we are in history.

In Reading we started, "Spy for the Night Riders." This is the story of Martin Luther the reformer. In Language Arts we focused on preposition phrases.

Math for 5th grade this week has been multiplying fractions. 6th grade is learning to form and solve algebraic expressions.

In Social Studies we learned about The Monroe Document, The Trail of Tears, and Andrew Jackson. Science focused on rocks and minerals. The students rotated centers to look at, touch, and identify rocks and minerals. We also performed a scratch test on minerals to determine their hardness.

Please remind students to read and earn AR points. They should have 40 points by the end of the year. Be sure

they study for MV, vocab, and spelling tests.
