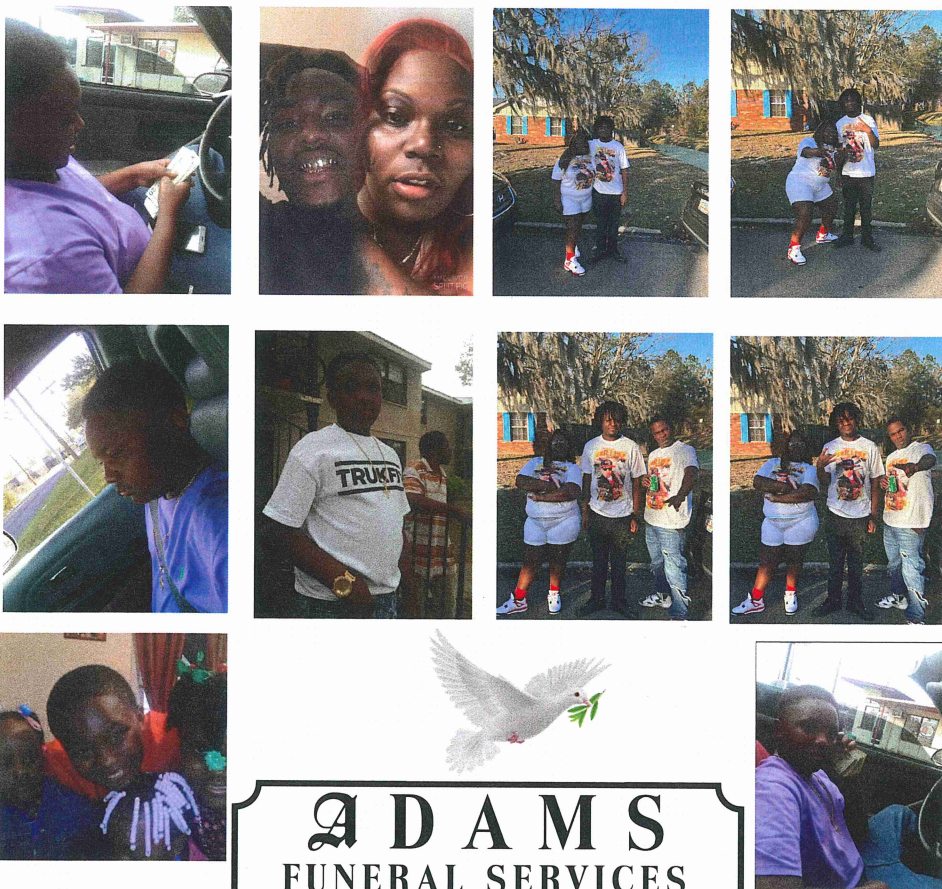



Acknowledgments

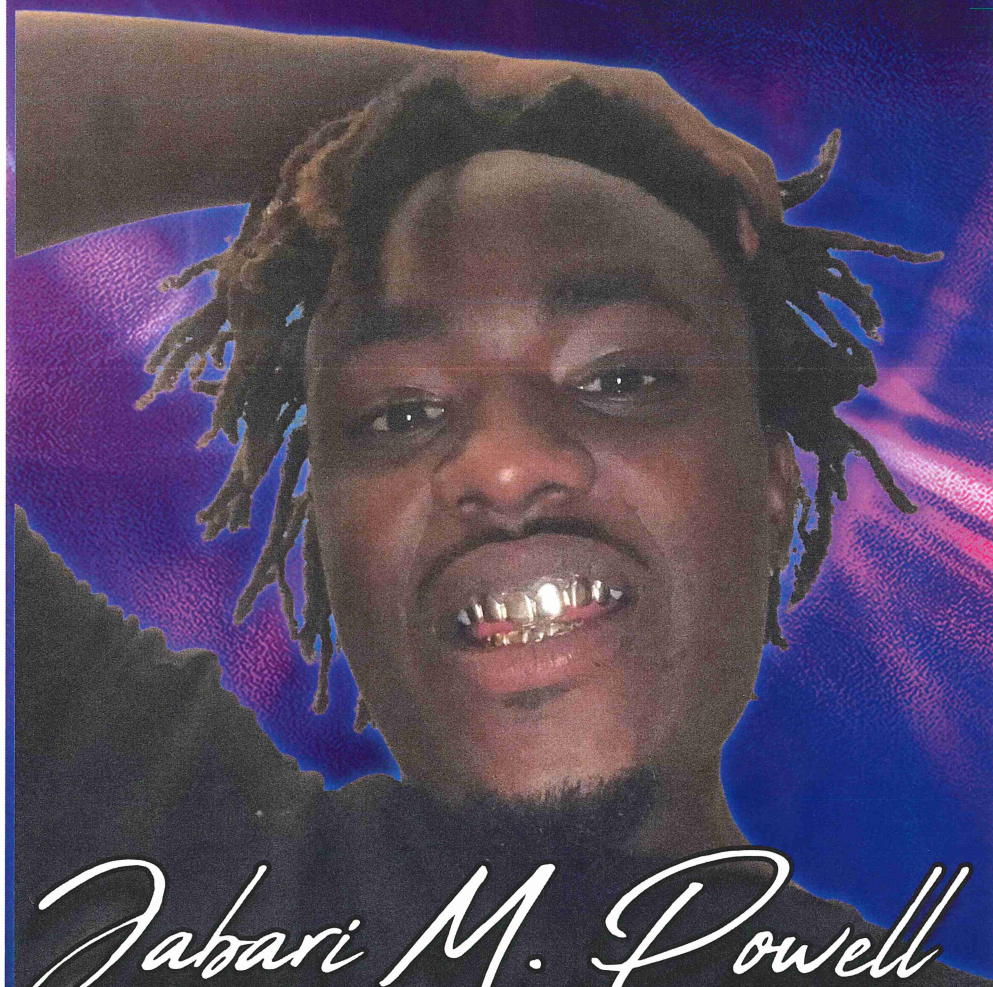
