The school's operational costs are subsidized by the Worthington Adventist Church and the Ohio Conference of Seventh-Day Adventists. This allows us to charge a reduced rate for all students. 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FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

The school board, faculty and administration make every effort possible to operate our school efficiently so that we can provide quality Christian education at a minimal cost. Without costs subsidized by the Ohio Conference, the expense per child would be thousands more per year. We recognize that, although tuition costs are as low as possible, the price is daunting for many families. Your local church or other organization may have Tuition Assistance, Scholarships, or Worthy Student Funds that your family may qualify for. We encourage you to explore this option.

TUITION PAYMENT OPTIONS

Tuition is charged per year, not per month. However, parents/guardians may elect to divide the tuition cost into monthly payments. The FACTS Tuition Management Company handles such accounts for the school (see the enclosed brochure for more information regarding FACTS). Monthly payments are equal regardless of the number of school days in the month.

For the 2018-2019 school year, I will pay my student's tuition by the payment option checked below:

OPTION 1 Full tuition payment made by August 14, 2018. I understand that:

- Payment will be made directly to the school. I will receive a 5% discount.
- Failure to pay by the designated date will result in assignment to FACTS.

OPTION 2 Monthly payments through FACTS automatically withdrawn from my checking account. I understand that:

- Payment will automatically be withdrawn from my checking account on the 5th or 20th of each month, according to my choice.
- The first payment month is August 2018.
- Tuition is divided into 10 monthly payments.
- I must submit the FACTS Automatic Tuition Payment Agreement to the school to enroll in this plan. If I enroll by August 1, the school will pay the \$43 enrollment fee.
- A fee of \$30.00 will be assessed by FACTS if insufficient funds are in my account when my payment is due. This is in addition to any fees my bank may charge.

PARENT/GUARDIAN FINANCIAL AGREEMENT
