Celebrating The Life Of Mary W. Wilken



March 12, 1940 October 12, 2022 Mary Wilhemina (Van Ballegooyen) Wilken was born at home on the farm north of Oak Grove State Park, north of Hawarden, Iowa, on March 12, 1940, the daughter of Andrew and Alice (Bryson) Van Ballegooyen. Mary and Billy spent many Saturday nights at the Brunsville Legion Hall at dances doing square dancing and polkas, after eating steak at a steak house. Mary enjoyed having coffee in the morning with her girlfriends in Hawarden and Ireton. She loved to have birthday parties, being together with her family on Sundays, and having Christmas at the farmhouse near McNally. She loved her children, grandchildren, and great-grandchildren. Mary had a strong faith in the Lord and was a member of the Lebanon Christian Reformed Church until she got married, and then they became members of the Associated Church in Hawarden in 1958.

Her husband Billy died on December 22, 2001. Mary died on Wednesday, October 12, 2022 at Akron Care Center at the age of 82 years.
