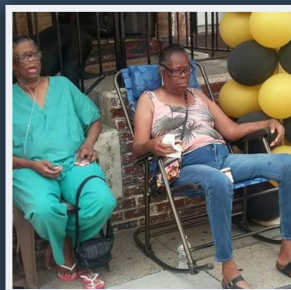


The Obituary
