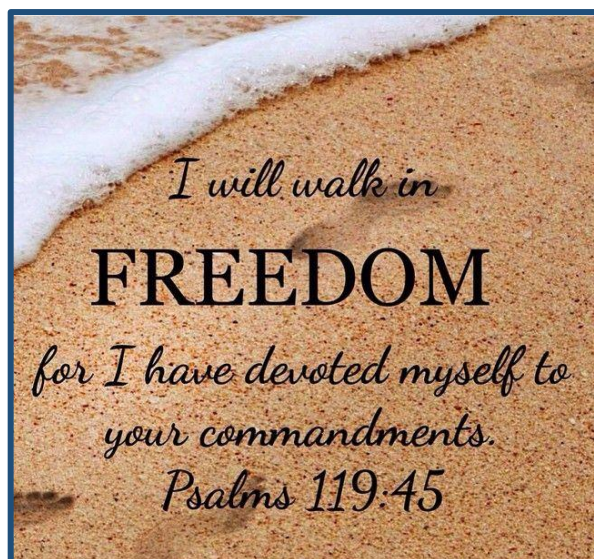

### For Today: A Message from Our Pastor “God Wrote Love”

The Ten Commandments are considered to be the definitive list of moral imperatives—“thou shalt nots” that define the boundary between right and wrong. But what if there is more to them? Jesus gave us a command to Love God and Love Your Neighbor, and many say these commands replace the Ten Commandments. This week, we will unpack a beautiful but rarely considered element of the Ten Commandments. Instead of examining the “thou shalt not” component of the law, we’re going to explore the “thou shalt” implications of the law—what each command implies about loving God or loving your neighbor. This is the first sermon in a series called *God Wrote Love*. In this series, we’ll discover why David said he loved the law, and why the apostles said the law is holy, just, and good. We’re going to find out that God’s law isn’t a limitation on our freedom, but a vast landscape of opportunity that enables joy and fulfillment. And we’re going to find that the Gospel story is woven all throughout these ten precepts. Join me on a journey to understand and fall in love with the Ten Commandments and their Designer.
