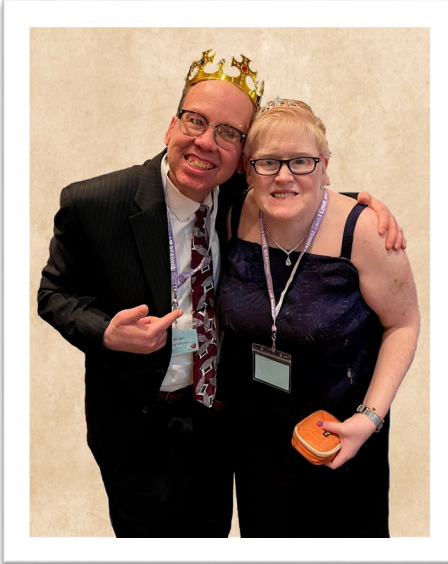


Remembering the Life....
