Shane Anthony Johnson

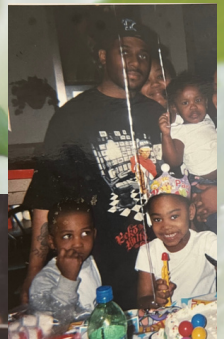
