

Remembering the Life of

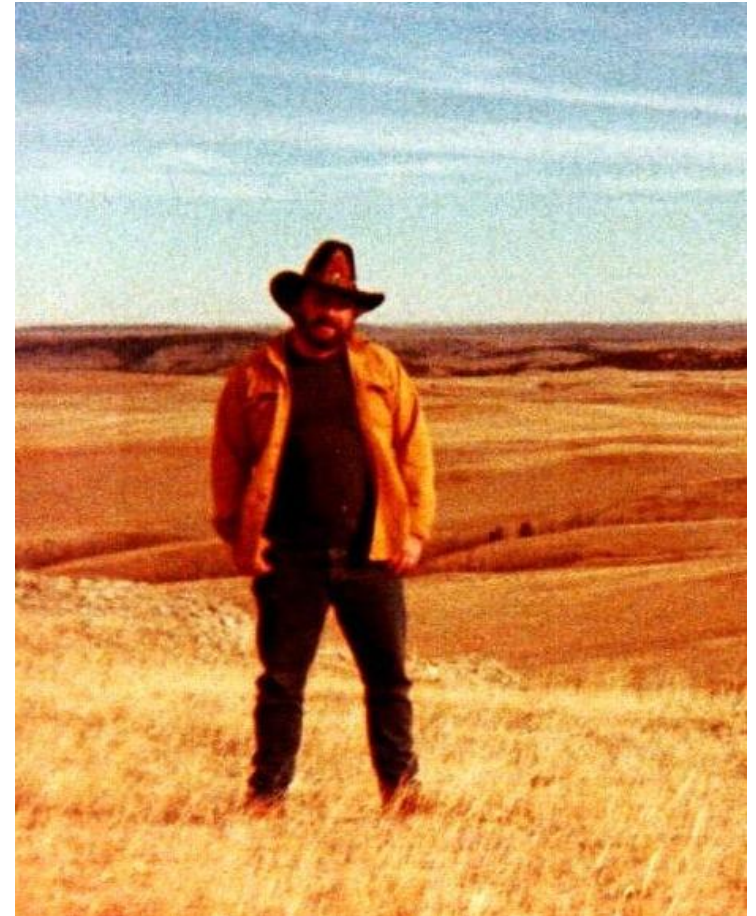
