Ted Engstrom in *The Pursuit of Excellence* writes:

*I was cleaning out a desk drawer when I found a flashlight I hadn't used in a year. I flipped the switch but wasn't surprised when it gave no light. I unscrewed it and shook it to get the batteries out, but they won't budge.*

*Finally, after some effort, they came loose. What a mess! Battery acid had corroded the entire inside of the flashlight. The batteries were new when I'd put them in a safe, warm place. But there was a problem. Those batteries weren't made to be warm and comfortable. They were designed to be turned on—to be used.*
